1.1 Introduction

The Primary Education Department, Zilla Parishad Latur supervises the educational activities and management of primary schools, secondary schools, non-government and aided schools, as well as ashram schools in the district. The officers working under the leadership of the Education Officer (Primary) are Deputy Education Officer, Group Education Officer and Center Head.

There are 1235 primary schools of Zilla Parishad and 49 Z.P. Schools in Latur district. There are also 487 aided and unaided private primary schools under the department. Out of these, 270 are Marathi medium primary schools, 101 are Urdu medium primary schools and 116 are English medium primary schools.

The work of supervision and control of the said schools is carried out by the Education Officer (Principal), two Deputy Education Officers (Principal), 10 Group Education Officers, 25 Senior Education Extension Officers, 18 Junior Education Extension Officers and 102 Center Heads.

The Education Extension Officer is expected to make at least 4 visits to each school in a year. This includes a surprise visit to the school, a second farewell visit, a third visit to inspect the school, and a fourth visit to guide them in correcting errors after the inspection. **1.2 Vision** and Mission
