- Benefit Amount: Rs. 50,000/-

6.2 Bicycle Distribution Scheme

- Backward class students from class 5th to 9th
- Distance from home to school is at least 2 km
- Benefit Amount: Rs. 7,192/-

6.3 Small Industry Assistance Scheme (Domestic Bells and Sewing Machines)

- Electricity connection required
- Benefit Amount: Rs. 21,780/- (Doorbell), Rs. 11,800/- (Sewing Machine)

6.4 Inter-caste Marriage Promotion Scheme

- Benefit Amount: Rs. 50,000/-

- One of the spouses should be from the Scheduled Caste/Tribe and the other should be from the upper caste community.

6.5 Self-employment Assistance Scheme for Persons with Disabilities

- Minimum 40% disability certificate
- Benefit Amount: Rs. 30,000/-
- Loan limit under Seed Capital Scheme: Rs. 10,000 to Rs. 1,50,000/-

- Benefit Amount: Rs. 4,500/-

6.7 Hostel Grant Scheme
