
?.? Introduction

District Water and Sanitation Mission is one of the important departments out of the total && departments in the Zilla Parishad. The Project Director (District Water and Sanitation Mission) is the head of this department. Training and awareness activities on various topics related to individual toilet construction, public toilet construction, sewage and solid waste management, dung collection, sewage management, plastic waste management and sanitation are implemented through this department.

१.२ Objectives

- I. Important schemes of the Central Government like Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) and Jal Jeevan Mission are implemented at the village level through the District Water and Sanitation Mission.
- II. Under the centrally sponsored scheme Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), an individual toilet incentive grant of Rs. \$7,000/- is provided to eligible beneficiaries through this department. Also, public toilet construction and solid waste and sewage management projects are implemented at the village level.
- III. The Jal Jeevan Mission, a centrally sponsored scheme, provides individual tap connections to families without individual tap connections.
- IV. Training and awareness activities on various topics related to sanitation are implemented through the District Water and Sanitation Mission.

११. Plastic waste management

Personal toilet:-

The Central Government has launched the Swachh Bharat Mission Scheme on %4 August %6%. Under this scheme, the benefit of incentive grant for individual toilets is provided to eligible families who do not have individual toilets as per the basic survey at the Gram Panchayat level. Palghar district has been declared as %4 districts of the state as open defectation free on %4 October %5. Under the Swachh Bharat Mission (Granny), public toilet construction, solid waste and sewage management as well as public awareness programs on cleanliness are implemented at the Gram Panchayat level.

Jaljeevan Mission :-

As per the guidelines issued by the Central Government on २५.१२.२०१९, the Central Government has decided to provide " Every house has tap water " (FHTC — Functional Household Tap Connection) is committed to providing water. The main objective of the Jal Jeevan Mission is to provide at least ५५ liters of quality water per capita per day through individual tap connection in every household in the rural areas of the state by the year २०२४. Under the Jal Jeevan Mission program, it is expected to provide water supply through individual taps to every family in all the slums in the districts of the state in a phased manner. This has been clarified in the Jal Jeevan guidelines. Similarly, the annual action plans prepared by the districts. It includes the work of corrective reconnection (retrofitting) for such individual tap connections.

Water Quality Monitoring and Survey Program :-

Twice a year under the Water Quality Monitoring and Survey Program A campaign is being implemented to collect public drinking water samples under the Gram Panchayat during the premonsoon period (November to May) and post-monsoon period (June to October) and send them to the sub-divisional laboratory for biological testing . Similarly, during the period of October to March, public drinking water samples are sent to the sub-divisional laboratory for chemical testing.

from schools, Anganwadis, FHTCs, and public drinking water are collected and subjected to biological and chemical testing using the FTK kit.

These water samples are collected by water conservationists through the WQMIS app and sent to the sub-divisional laboratory for testing. Also , a cleanliness survey campaign is conducted twice a year, before the monsoon (April % to April %) and after the monsoon (October % to October %). After the survey, green , yellow or red cards are distributed to the Gram Panchayats.

Sant Gadge Baba's Village Cleanliness Campaign :-

The main objective of the village cleanliness program is to improve the health of the rural people. With the view that the rural people should feel this program and convince them of its importance and get them to participate spontaneously, Sant Gadge Baba Village Cleanliness Campaign, Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Swachh Gram Competition are being implemented since २०००-२००१. Also, since २००२-०३, Gram Panchayats, Talukas, who have been doing significant work in a specific field related to cleanliness and rural development, An initiative to give special prizes was started at the district, division and state levels. From the year २०१८-१९, new guidelines are being issued every year from the government level. Accordingly, from the year २०१८-१९, prizes are being given to the best faculty at the Gram Panchayat level and the best Gram Panchayat in the Zilla Parishad group for doing significant work in the field of cleanliness in the Sant Gadge Maharaj Gram Swachhta Abhiyan competition.
