Brief information about Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) Scheme

1) Personal toilet –

Rural areas under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) Phase- 2 Encouraging families to construct and maintain individual toilets Building their capacity to use , its sustainability Drainage pit and manure pit in village sewage and solid waste management Their construction , plastic waste collection , schools and anganwadis as well as Sanitation in all important public institutions and places Providing amenities , keeping the village clean, etc. Integration of works All the above facilities will

improve the health of people in rural areas. And keeping them free from diseases caused by unsanitary conditions is the key. The goal is.

Eligible rural areas under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) Phase -2 Government incentive grant for construction of individual toilets for families So a subsidy of Rs . 12000/- (Twelve thousand rupees only) is available. This scheme The benefit is available to eligible families in the following categories – such as ,

- **APL (Above Poverty Line) –**
- Scheduled Caste (SC)
- Scheduled Tribes (ST)
- Small & Marginal Farmer
- Bhumihin (Landless)
- Handicap
- Women Headed Family

- **BPL (Below Poverty Line) –**
- Scheduled Caste (SC)
- Scheduled Tribes (ST)
- General

Eligible families under Swachh Bharat Mission (Rural) Phase- 2 To get incentive grant for construction of individual toilets The required documents are as follows –

- 1) Certificate that the beneficiary has available space for the construction of a personal toilet.
- 2) Toilet construction completion certificate.
- 3) Proposal of Gram Panchayat –
- 4) Certificate of not having received any grant from any scheme before.
- 5) Gram Panchayat Form No. 8 Extract.
 - Utility Certificate (whether the beneficiary has water available for the toilet and is using the toilet)

- the SBM central website.
- Toilet construction completion certificate and copy of color photo including beneficiaries of individual toilets.
- Guarantee Letter – If subsidy has been received from any scheme earlier, then a guarantee letter for legal recovery of the said amount from the beneficiary.

2) Public toilet –

Rural areas under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) Phase- 2 Public toilets at bus stands , market places , temples and pilgrimage sites The facility of giving is made under this scheme. This benefit It is not a problem if the Gram Panchayat has land available for acquisition. The proposal along with the certificate has to be submitted to the District Office. Public The total cost of the toilet is Rs 3 lakh and it is funded by Swachh Bharat Mission (Rural). Two lakh ten thousand rupees under Phase -2 and under the 15th Finance Commission A provision of ninety thousand rupees is made.

3) Solid waste and sewage management –

Open defecation free areas under Swachh Bharat Mission (Rural) Phase -2 In the second phase, to make villages open defecation free (ODF PLUS) There must be solid waste and sewage management at the village level, including toilets. For this, solid waste and sewage are collected according to the population and number of families at the village level. Management plans are prepared. For this work, 70% share is provided under Swachh Bharat Mission (Rural) Phase -2 and 30% funds are provided from the 15th Finance Commission. There is a provision to provide.
