□ Objectives:

1. Increasing the birth rate of girls
2. Promoting education
3. Preventing child marriage
4. Reducing malnutrition
5. Bringing the rate of out-of-school girls to 0

₹ Nature of benefit (Total ₹1,01,000/-):

Stage	Benefit (₹)	Required documents
Birth of a daughter	₹5000	Birth certificate , girl born in a specific month
etc. Upon admission to the 1st	₹6000	Aadhar card , school certificate
etc. After taking admission in 6th standard	₹7000	School certificate
etc. After taking admission in 11th standard	₹8000	School certificate
After completing 18 years of age (if unmarried)	₹75,000	Self-declaration , name in voter list , identity card

Terms and Conditions:

- Girl born after April 1, 2023
- The family must have a yellow/orange ration card.
- Annual income below ₹1 lakh
- The beneficiary should be unmarried.
- Family planning certificate required
- Only applies to one or two girls

Required documents:

1. Girl's birth certificate
2. Income certificate (from Tehsildar)
3. Aadhar card (of daughter and parents)
4. School bonafide certificate
5. Joint bank account (daughter and mother)
6. Ration card
7. Name in the voter list (at the age of 18)
8. Family planning certificate
9. Self-declaration of being single

- Nearby **At the Anganwadi Center** Go and bring the necessary documents.
Online/Offline Apply.

How to get the benefit ?

- Benefit amount **DBT (Direct Benefit Transfer)** By daughter and mother **In a joint account** Will be deposited.

Integrated Child Development Service Scheme , (District Level) , Women and Child Development Department ,

Zilla Parishad , Latur.

1. Training girls for self-defense and their physical development.
2. Counseling center for women.
3. Computer training for girls from class 7th to 12th pass.
4. exemplary Anganwadi workers , helpers , and supervisors.
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Criteria/Terms and Conditions for Personal Benefit Plans:

1. To those who submit proposals through recognized organizations. (Training)
2. Those who have at least 07th pass training. (Training)

3. Should be a resident of Nanded district. (Residency Certificate)
 4. The family's income for the previous year should be within Rs. ₹1,20,000/- .
 5. Must not have previously benefited from these schemes.
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1. Supply of various materials to Anganwadis:

The said materials include various types of toys that promote educational and intellectual development ,

toys necessary for physical development , educational charts , child tracking software ,

best scales , electronic scales , infrared stadiometer , water purification device, table , chair , cupboards, slipper stand , steel dishes , spoons , glasses , chess , bag straps , digital watches , computers , uniform distribution to boys/girls in Anganwadi, etc.

Materials will be supplied.

02. Supplementary feeding for malnourished children and adolescent girls, pregnant and lactating mothers:

Within the scope of work of Anganwadi in rural areas **6 months to 3 years** And **3 years to 6 years** Children of all ages are provided free meals through Anganwadi.

In addition, to reduce the rate of malnutrition among malnourished children, **Special diet** Protein syrup , protein powder , micronutrient supplementation syrup , mineral vitamins should be supplied.

Also according to local availability **Milk , soy milk , chickpeas , laddu , eggs , jaggery, peanuts** etc. nutritious and protein-rich diet as well as for pregnant and lactating mothers and adolescent girls **Iron tablets** Must give.

Teenager **In-school/out-of-school children aged 13 to 19 living below the poverty line**
Girls need **Free distribution of health materials** (e.g. sanitary napkins etc.)
