1. The beneficiary should be a Scheduled Caste/Newlywed farmer.
2. The farmer should have a caste certificate issued by the concerned authority.
3. a) The farmer should have a minimum land holding of 0.40 ha for availing the benefit of the new well component. b) A united family holding a minimum of 0.40 ha of collective agricultural land is eligible for the new well component. There will be water for taking advantage.
A) The maximum agricultural land requirement under the said scheme is 6.00 hectares.
4. The farmer must have 7/12 certificate and 8 A extract of land tenure in his name. (Outside Nagar Panchayat, Nagarpalika and Mahanagarpalika areas)
5. The beneficiary must have Aadhaar card.
6. The beneficiary must have a bank account and the said bank account must be linked with Aadhaar card.
7. Land allotment under the Gai Kamveer Dadasaheb Gaikwad Empowerment and Pride Scheme
The farmers should be given the benefit of this scheme.

b) A joint family holding at least 0.40 acres of collective agricultural land will be eligible to avail the benefit of the new well component.

A) The maximum agricultural land requirement under the said scheme is

6.00 ha. 4. The farmer should have 7/12 certificate and 8A extract of his/her land tenure.
