1) Supply of livestock to Scheduled Tribe beneficiaries for complementary business to agriculture – Supply of goat group (10+1)

This is an annual scheme under which beneficiaries of Scheduled Tribes **10+1 goat** group allocation It can be done.

- In a group 10 goats and 1 buck It is given.
- 1 goat: ₹8,000
- 1 goat: ₹10,000
- Total cost for the group: ₹1,03,545
 - Government Subsidy (75%): ₹77,659
 - Beneficiary share (25%): ₹25,886

₹13,545 for a 10+1 goat group for three years .

Priority when selecting beneficiaries:

- 1. Beneficiaries below poverty line
- 2. Smallholder farmers (landholding up to 1 hectare)
- 3. Small landholder farmers (landholders of 1 to 2 hectares)
- 4. Educated unemployed (registered in employment and self-employment accounts)
- 5. Beneficiaries of Women's Self-Help Groups (falling into any of the categories 1 to 4 above)

2) Group allocation of milch animals for Scheduled Caste-Tribe beneficiaries (Annual Plan)

Beneficiary Class: Scheduled Castes , Scheduled Tribes (Tribals and outside tribal areas)

Scheme Objective:

To distribute a group of milch animals (2 animals)

1. Group allocation of hybrid cows:

- Price per cow: ₹70,000
- Total cost for 2 cows: ₹1,40,000
- Government Subsidy (75%): ₹1,05,000
- Beneficiary share (25%): ₹35,000
- Sum insured for 3 years: ₹16,850 (Compulsory)

2. Group allocation of Murha/Jaffrabadi buffaloes:

- Price per buffalo: ₹80,000
- Total cost for 2 buffaloes: ₹1,60,000
- Government Grant (75%): ₹1,34,443
- Beneficiary Share (25%): ₹44,815
- Sum insured for 3 years: ₹19,258 (Compulsory)

Priority in selecting beneficiaries (in order):

- 1. Beneficiaries below poverty line
- 2. Smallholder farmers (up to 1 hectare)
- 3. Small landholder farmers (1 to 2 hectares)
- 4. Educated unemployed (registered with employment/self-employment office)
- 5. Beneficiaries of Women's Self-Help Groups (out of 1 to 4 above)

3) Medicine supply scheme for goats , sheep and cattle of Scheduled Caste beneficiaries

Objective: To provide the following facilities to goats

, sheep , chickens and cattle of Scheduled Caste beneficiaries :

- To water with insecticides
- Annotating (tagging/marking)
- Measures to control parasitic insects

Beneficiary Eligibility:

- The beneficiary should be from a Scheduled Caste.
- The beneficiary should have goats , sheep , chickens or other livestock.

This scheme aims to improve the health of animals and provides assistance to beneficiaries through free or subsidized medicines and remedies.

4) Integrated Poultry Development Program

Plan Type: Annual Plan (General)

Objective of the scheme: To provide a batch of

100- day-old broiler chickens to eligible beneficiaries as per government decisions and guidelines .

- Total cost: ₹29,500/-
- Government Subsidy (50%): ₹14,750/-
- The remaining amount is to be paid by the beneficiary.

This scheme is implemented to promote poultry farming as a means of livelihood, especially for the poor and unemployed in rural areas.

5) Exhibitions and fairs for animal husbandry

Under this annual scheme (general) for animal husbandry, exhibitions and char removal are being organized in the districts under the Zilla Parishad and in Jalkot , Udgir , Deoni and Latur. **4 animal exhibitions are organized** .

At this animal exhibition:

- Male and female gods
- Red-eared slider male and female
- Hybrid breed female
- Other males and females

• Osmanabad goat (with three kids)

The best animals are selected from this group and given prizes.

Animal exhibitions and fairs (people participation based)

This is a Zilla Parishad Sub-Aid Scheme to organize animal exhibitions and fairs at the taluka level:

- 25% of the population of the Gram Panchayat
- 25% public share of Panchayat Samiti Cess

Only after this is paid, 50% of the amount is made available from the district provision.

In these exhibitions, prizes are awarded to the best animals from the abovementioned breeds.

6) Improvement Program for Feed Availability for Dairy Animals / Veiran and Animal Feed Program

Under this Annual Plan (General) **Improvement Program for Feed Availability for Dairy Animals / Veiran and Animal Feed Program** It is implemented.

Under this:

- 100% subsidy for veiran production in 1 hectare (2.5 acres) area It is given.
- Supply of Vairani seeds/drip irrigation up to Rs. 4000/- It is done.

Beneficiaries for this scheme At least 3 to 4 animals Must have.
