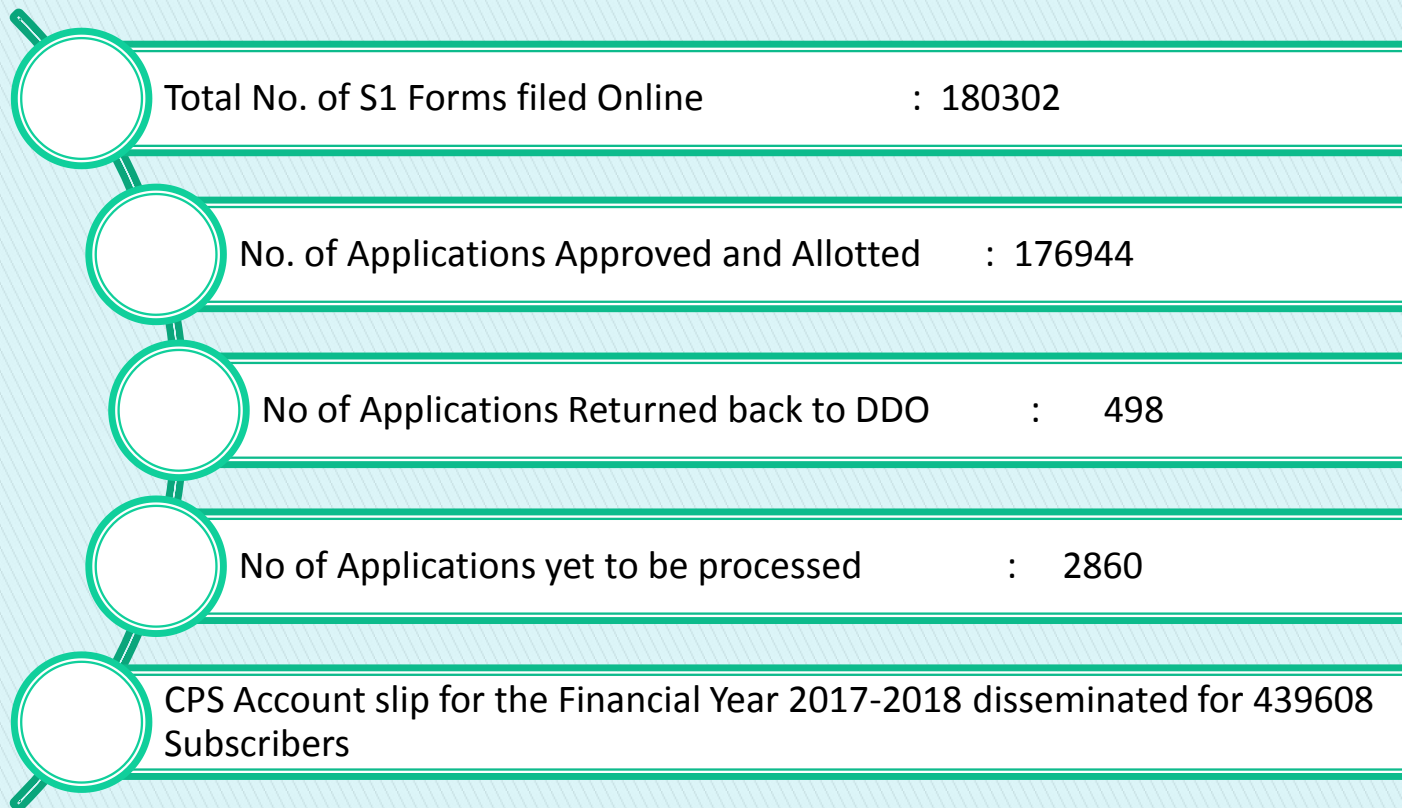

TN State Spatial Data Infrastructure – TNGIS

Tamil Nadu State Spatial Data Infrastructure (TNSSDI) is an initiative from IT Department, Govt. of Tamil Nadu aimed at collating the geo-spatial data from various State Govt. Departments, organization of datasets as per the defined standards, design and development of TNGIS-TNSSDI portal as a one-stop-source for all the geospatial data.

- ❖ Built Completely on Open Source GIS Tools.
- ❖ Creation of Centralized Geo-Spatial data repository comprising of 350+ Vector layers and 33000+ scanned village maps in PostgreSQL with PostGIS
- ❖ Setting up of Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) based framework for dissemination of GIS layers using GeoServer GIS Web Server
- ❖ Responsive Web design using Leaflet JavaScript library.
- ❖ Districts / Departments/ Roles / users based authentication.
- ❖ TN Base map with 18 layers at 10 different scale levels as per the global standards like Google, Bing etc.
- ❖ Area of Interest Tool, Buffer, Geocoding, Network analysis using free and open API's.
- ❖ Progressive Web application created for Crowd Sourced Spatial Data creation.
- ❖ Service based Thematic Map Implementation for State Govt. Schemes.
- ❖ Upload Spatial data in Shape files / GPX formats Framework.
- ❖ Mashup with Online Web Map services like OSM,ESRI etc.

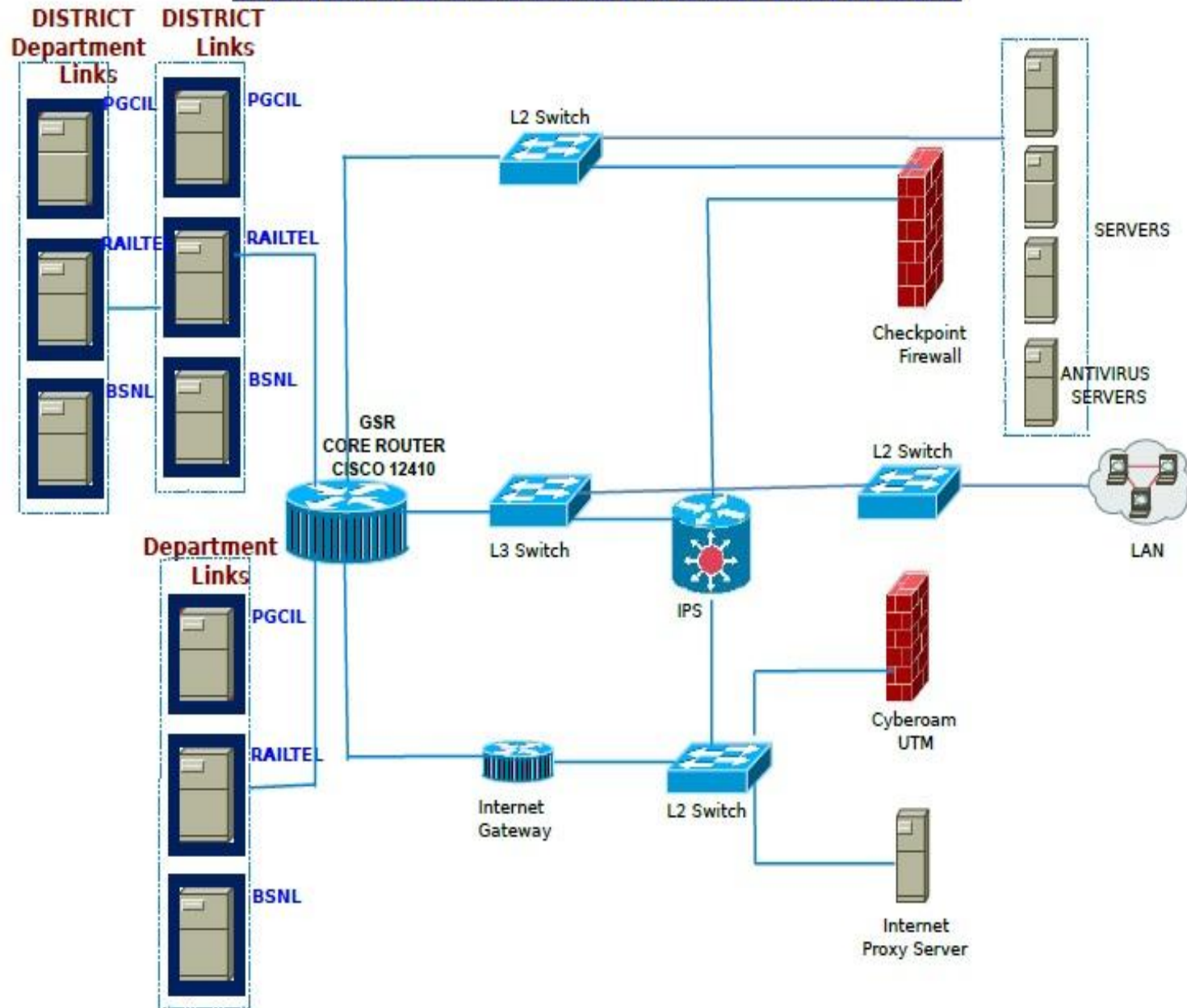
Implementation

- ❖ The website was formally launched by the then Chief Minister on 5th August 2016.
- ❖ 32 Stake holder's spatial data collated and integrated in the system. Around 500 users credentials created for various State Govt. Department Officials and 4000 public users registered for accessing TNGIS.

Milestone

- ❖ SDSS for SSA for
 - Identification of unserved hamlets for Primary, Upper Primary, High and Hr Sec Schools.
 - Identification of unserved hamlets for Residential Schools / Hostels
 - Identification of schools for upgradation in unserved regions.
- ❖ SDSS for 108 Ambulance Services for using dynamic Grid / Cluster / Proximity Analysis
 - Identification of high density accident zones
 - Identification of roads having maximum no. of accidents
 - Identification of critical zones without 108 services within any given distance.
 - Identification of critical zones without Trauma Care facility
 - Impact: Response time for 108 Service reduced from 18 to 14 minutes (State average) and 10,000 additional RTA availed
- ❖ Cyclone relief Work: TNGIS application was extensively used in the GAJA cyclone relief work for four affected districts namely Pudukottai, Thiruvavur, Nagapattinam and Thanjavur especially with the restoration of electricity supply to the households.
- ❖ Election GIS: Election GIS has been successfully demonstrated for Tirunelveli District, TN during the General Elections held in April 2019.
- ❖ Developed Mobile GIS application for capturing geographic location details of dengue cases in Kanyakumari District, TN.

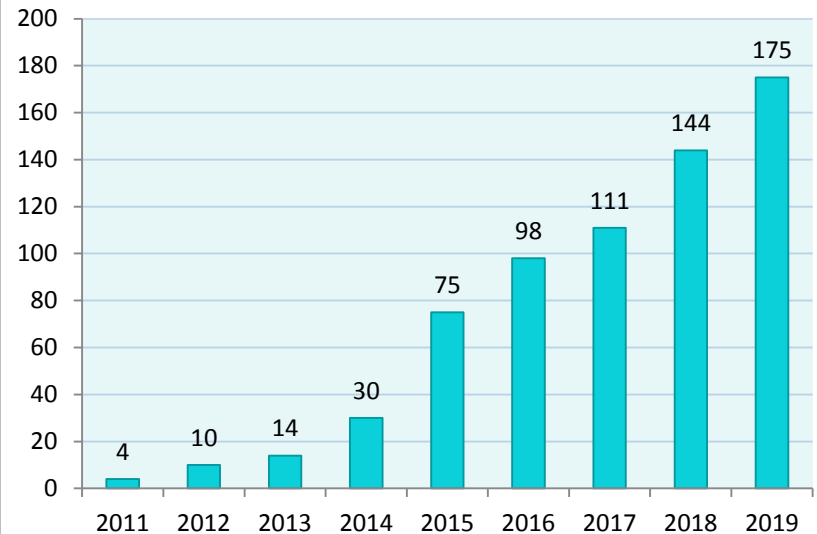
