30 TH OCTOBER, 30 TH NOVEMBER, 30 TH DECEMBER, 2026	• Transmission of data in prescribed format (<i>Annexure B</i>) to the MCPC by the nodal officer to the designated email ID : med4nation.nalsamcpc@sci.nic.in
