In exercise of the powers conferred by article 233 read with proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules with a view to further amend the Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service Rules, 2004.

The Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules 2024

Short title and Commencement 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Rule 30

2. In the Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service Rules, 2004 for existing rule 30, as set out in column 1 below, the rule as set out in column-2 shall be substituted, namely-

Column 1 Existing Rule	Column 2 Rule hereby Substituted
In regards to the matters not specifically covered by these rules or by special order, persons appointed to this service shall be governed by the rules, regulations and orders applicable generally to Government Servants serving in connection with the affairs of Uttarakhand State. Provided that in computing the

minimum period of service qualifying for full pension and other benefits, which is 20 years, in case the years of service of a direct recruit fall short, the number of years of practice at the bar, whichever is less, subject to a maximum of 10 years, shall be added to the service of a directly recruited member from the Bar, subject to the condition that weightage of practice at the Bar will be given only if the direct recruit actually serves a minimum period of 10 years. The said benefit will be admissible only to officers eligible for OPS (Old Pension Scheme).
