In exercise of the powers conferred by article 233 read with proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules in view to further amend the Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service Rules, 2004, and Rules 2024 namely :-

The Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules 2025

Short title and Commencement 1.(1) These Rules may be called the Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules, 2025.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

Amendment of Rule 15 2. In the Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service Rules, 2004 (hereinafter referred to as principal rules) and Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules, 2024 for existing sub-rule (ii) of Rule 15, as set out in column 1 below, the sub-rule as set out in column-2 shall be substituted, namely-

(ii) The Chief Justice or Committee constituted by the Chief Justice shall prescribe the pattern and syllabus of competitive examination which shall be finalized after approval of the State Government.

Amendment of Rule 19 3. In the Principal rules 2004 and Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules, 2024 for existing sub-rule (ii) of Rule 19, as set out in column 1 below, the sub-rule as set out in column-2 shall be substituted, namely-
