Subject: Inappropriate practice of declining to accept the filing of Civil Suits/Appeals/Revisions/Review etc.

Sir/Madam,

On the subject noted above, it has come to the notice of the Hon'ble High Court that Readers/Munsarims of certain Subordinate Courts in the State are declining orally to accept the filing of Civil Suits/Appeals/Revisions/Review etc., without any written order or without proper presentation of the Suit before the concerned Court on the grounds that the Court lacks territorial, pecuniary or subject-matter jurisdiction. Such practice is contrary to the procedure prescribed under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

2. In the matter, I have been directed to inform that all Subordinate Courts must strictly follow the provisions of **Order VII Rule 10 and Order VII Rule 10A of CPC**, which clearly mandate the procedure in such circumstances.

3. You are therefore, requested to ensure compliance in the matter and communicate such directions to all concerned.
