**Subject:- Clarification on Allowances Admissible to the Judicial Officers.**

Kindly take reference of judgment dated 04.01.2024 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in Writ Petition No. 643 of 2015 titled as "*All India Judges Association vs. Union of India*" and G.O.s of State Government dated 23.02.2024, 30.04.2024 & 16.10.2024.

2. In this regard, on several issues District Judges have sought clarification. On these clarifications, I have been directed to inform you that:-

- a) **Administrative Work Allowance**- For departments such as Stationery, Account, Nazarat, Copying, Record Room, etc., which have been mentioned in General Rules Civil/General Rules Criminal as well as all such departments which are created from time to time as per need of the work such as Computer department, In-charge will be given administrative work allowance as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court given in All India Judges Association case Judgment dated 04.01.2024. For departmental inquiries, being members of Administrative Committees etc. no allowance seems justifiable; because such functions are not routine functions for other judicial officers except District Judge, who is departmental head. Similarly, Jail visit, observation home visit is not done by

the other officers except CJM or Principal Magistrate JJB and that is also once in a month, therefore, for such visits giving Administrative Allowance does not seem justifiable.

- b) **Concurrent Charge Allowance**- Concurrent/Additional Charge Allowance will be given to all officers holding an additional charge of a post for more than 10 working days and the Notification No. 413 dated 16.10.2024 will be followed for all additional charges of a post. However, if only powers of a particular Judge or Magistrate under Special Act are conferred upon the officer, then no additional charge will be admissible. District Judges/DDOs will ensure before giving additional charge allowance to the Principal Magistrate, JJB that the post is created *vide* Notification of State Government and Officer has been given charge of post of Principal Magistrate, JJB in pursuance of notification of High Court which he held for more than 10 working days. For mere conferment of powers, in addition to substantive duties given to Judge or Magistrates, such allowance will not be admissible and if any DDOs have given additional allowance to such Magistrates, without having additional charge of that post, same shall be recovered from the officer by DDOs of concerned district.
- c) **Transfer Grant**- Composite Transfer Grant will be admissible to both the husband and wife posted in the same district and living in the same accommodation and also going on transfer to same place. Hence, on transfer of husband and wife from one place to other place simultaneously, each of them will be entitled to claim composite transfer grant equivalent to one month of his/her basic pay. All the DDOs are directed to comply with the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court and Government Notification dated 23.02.2024 in letter and spirit.
- d) **Home Orderly Allowance**- Both the officers (*Husband & Wife*) are Judicial Officers in their individual capacity, none

of two can be given precedence over other; both go to their work separately, therefore, each one is eligible for home Orderly/Domestic Help Allowance. All the DDOs are directed to follow the G.O. dated 23.02.2024 in letter and spirit.

- e) **Mobile Phone Facility-** Mobile phone facility to permissible user for monthly bill inclusive internet DATA package as directed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in order dated 04.01.2024 passed in All India Judges Association Case may be directly included in the salary of Judicial Officers on the line of Newspaper allowance, which have been made part of allowance in the salary slip itself vide G.O. No. 88/XXXVI-A-/1/2024-261/2022 (E-68460) dated 23.02.2024 and earlier practice of claiming reimbursement for mobile bill may be dispensed with. All the DDOs are directed to add this allowance to salary of Officers as mobile facility allowance.

3. The above instructions shall be strictly followed.
