Subject: Amendment in Circular Letter No. 16/UHC/Admn.A-33/2010 dated 09.12.2010 regarding submission of Comprehensive Medical/Health Check-up Reports of Judicial Officers.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Court's Circular Letter No. 16/UHC/Admn.A-33/2010 dated 09.12.2010 regarding comprehensive medical/health check-up of Judicial Officers.

2. Upon consideration, it has been decided that, while the requirement of undergoing comprehensive medical/health check-up twice in a calendar year, i.e., during the months of June and December, shall continue to remain in force,

the requirement of forwarding copies of the medical/health check-up reports to the High Court is hereby dispensed with.

3. Accordingly, the Judicial Officers shall continue to undergo the prescribed medical examinations as stipulated in the aforesaid Circular. However, they shall retain the original medical/health check-up reports in their personal custody/official record, and no copy thereof shall be forwarded to the High Court.

4. The District Judges shall ensure compliance with the requirement of periodic medical/health check-up by the Judicial Officers working under their respective Judgeships. However, they shall not transmit the medical reports to the High Court, unless specifically called for by this Court.

5. Except to the extent modified hereinabove, all other terms and conditions contained in Circular Letter No. 16/UHC/Admn.A-33/2010 dated 09.12.2010 shall remain unchanged and continue to be in force.

6. This Circular shall come into force with immediate effect.
