Subject: Procedure for grant of LL.M. Allowance to the Judicial Officers of the Uttarakhand Judicial Service and Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service.

Sir/Madam,

It has come to the notice of the Hon'ble High Court that proposals relating to grant of LL.M. Allowance to the Judicial Officers are being processed and sanctioned by certain authorities without prior scrutiny and approval of the Hon'ble High Court.

2. In order to ensure uniformity, proper verification, and compliance with the applicable Government Orders, it is hereby directed that:

(i) Every proposal for grant of LL.M. Allowance in respect of a member of the Uttarakhand Judicial Service or Uttarakhand Higher Judicial Service shall invariably be forwarded to the High Court through the concerned District Judge/Head of Office with all relevant documents.

(ii) The proposal shall include copies of the LL.M. degree, mark sheets, proof regarding recognition of the University/Institution, prior permission of the Hon'ble High Court (where applicable), and any other relevant documents required for verification.

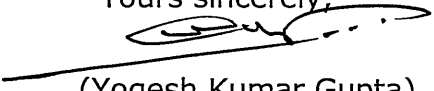
(iii) No District Judge, Head of Office, Drawing and Disbursing Officer, Treasury Officer, or any other authority shall sanction LL.M. Allowance without prior approval/sanction of the Hon'ble High Court.

(iv) The allowance shall be sanctioned only after receipt of approval/sanction from the Hon'ble High Court.

3. All the District Judges, Heads of Office, and the Director, Treasury, Pension & Entitlements, Uttarakhand are requested to ensure strict compliance with these directions.

4. This Circular shall come into force with immediate effect.

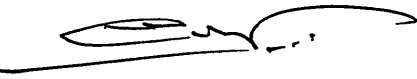
