Subject: Holding of Camp Courts at Outlying Court Stations during adverse weather conditions through Video Conferencing/postponement/rescheduling.

Sir/Madam,

Camp Courts are periodically held by the Judicial Officers at certain outlying court stations in the State, particularly in remote and hilly areas. During the rainy season and periods of snowfall, such areas are often affected by adverse weather conditions, including heavy rainfall, snowfall, landslides, road blockages and other natural hazards, which may render travel unsafe and impede the holding of Camp Courts as per the scheduled programme. In order to ensure the safety of

Judicial Officers, Advocates, court staff, litigants and all concerned, while at the same time ensuring continuity of judicial work, following guidelines are issued:

1. Where the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued an Alert, or any other warning indicating severe weather conditions for the concerned district/outlying court station, and travel to such station is likely to pose a risk due to heavy rain, snowfall, landslides, road blockage or other natural calamities, the District Judge concerned shall assess the prevailing situation.

2. If, upon such assessment, the District Judge is satisfied that it would not be safe or feasible for the Judicial Officer to travel to and hold the Camp Court at the scheduled outlying station, the District Judge may, in exceptional circumstances:

(i) permit the Camp Court proceedings to be conducted through Video Conferencing, wherever feasible and permissible in accordance with law; or

(ii) postpone/reschedule the Camp Court to a suitable date, having regard to administrative convenience and the interests of justice.

2. The power under this Circular shall be exercised only in genuine and exceptional circumstances arising out of adverse weather conditions and shall not be treated as a routine measure.

3. The District Judge shall maintain an appropriate record of the reasons for such decision and shall ensure that all concerned stakeholders are informed of the change in schedule through appropriate means at the earliest.

4. As soon as the weather conditions improve and travel becomes reasonably safe, the postponed Camp Court shall be held on a rescheduled date as may be fixed by the District Judge.

5. All the District Judges are directed to ensure compliance with the above instructions.
