<u>Vidhayak Adarsh Gram Yojana now Vidhayak Adarsh Nagar Avam Gram Yojana</u> (VANGY) Funding Pattern : 100% State

The State Govt. launched Vidhayak Adarsh Gram Yojana (VAGY) for the holistic development of villages identified by the Hon'ble MLAs of the State. Under this scheme, the State Govt. has decided on 26.12.2018 that an amount of Rs.2.00 crore will be provided for each constituency every year. This amount can be spent in one or more villages. However, for every individual village, the amount shall be limited to only one of the three amounts i.e. Rs.50.00 lacs for the village having population of 5000 and Rs.1.00 crore for village having population more than 5000 but less than 10000 and Rs.2.00 crore for village having population more than 5000 but less than 10000 and Rs.2.00 crore for village having population more than 10000.

Now the scheme has been renamed as Vidhayak Adarsh Nagar Avam Gram Yojana (VANGY). Hon'ble MLAs can execute Development works in urban areas like Nagar Nigam, Nagar Parishads and Nagar Palika in apart from those of Rural Areas.
