STANDING ORDER NO . 1 /2010-11 RECOVERIES FROM THE STAFF

The Standing Order No. 1/1998-99 describes in detail the procedure for effecting recoveries from the delinquent officials for the shortage of work, particularly, the plantation and nursery works. It is silent on the shortage of forest produce in forest and sale depots under the charge of logg ng staff.

Many such instances have come to notice, wherein, after enquiry the enquiry officers have recommended imposition of recoveries from officials working in the logging divisions for shortages of forest produce in forest and sale depots.

It is hereby ordered that while all other procedure for effecting the recovery of such shortages will remain the same as given in the Standing Order No. 1/1998-99, the ratio of percentage of recovery to be effected from the Range Officer and Felling Incharge, who may be Forest Guard or Forester, will be 40%: 60% respectively. This is because in logging divisions the Felling Incharge (Forest Guard or Forester) directly functions under the Range Officer.

This standing order will have prospective effect and will be effective forthwith.
