Capacity Building webinar on Vulnerability Assessment in Haryana

The Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India is working to map the National Vulnerability in context of Climate Change and to generate a National Vulnerability Map at the state and district level for states. Also, vulnerability assessment is a key component to be incorporated in the revision of the State Action Plan on Climate Change (SAPCC) by all the states. In this regard, they organised a preliminary workshop on 'National Level Vulnerability Mapping' during February 12-15, 2020 at New Delhi in coordination with Indian Institute of Science (IISc.), IIT Mandi and IIT Guwahati with the state governments towards capacity building of the state for vulnerability assessment.

Therefore, Environment and Climate Change Department, Haryana tends to conduct the three days training program on 'Capacity Building Workshop on Vulnerability Assessment in Haryana State' at Chandigarh for State Government Officials and Stakeholders. The participation of state line departments and stakeholder is required for the data collection and preparation of vulnerability profiles at district level in the state. The aim of the workshop is to introduce the concepts of climate change vulnerability, to provide understanding about the need of vulnerability assessment, selection of indictors at district and sectoral level in the state and to give hand on training sessions on preparing vulnerability profiles to the Government Officials and stakeholders of the state.
