## THE UTTARAKHAND APPROPRIATION (VOTE ON ACCOUNT) ACT, 2016

(No. 33 of 2016)

128th May, 20161

An Act to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand for the services of a part of the financial year 2016-2017.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as

1. (1) This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act,

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of thirteen thousand six hundred forty-two crore, forty-three lakh, eighty-five thousand rupees towards defruying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2016-2017 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 2016

## THE GAZETTE OF INDIA EXTRAORDINARY

Appropriation

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.

4. (1) The Uttarakhand Appropriation (Vote on Account) Ordinance, 2016 is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the provisions of this Act.
