India has been considerably investing in science, technology and innovation over the past few years. This has led to a change in the R&D landscape of the country.

However, to fully realize the potential, it is important that the state prepares its R&D Budget. This will enable states to allocate resources efficiently and in a transparent fashion across Sectors / Departments towards R&D in order to promote innovation at the gross-roots. Infact the R&D Budget is the instrument to enable the State Government to take a focused approach to R&D with identifiable outputs and outcome and enrich its R&D ecosystem.

Regarding this our office had requested Reserve Bank of India to compile the R&D Expenditure Data of State Governments for 3 Years. RBI compiled this information and prepared a report which was shared by my predecessor with you (copy enclosed). This letter sought your comments on RBI study report and requested you to nominate a nodal officer who will coordinate with this office for preparation of R&D State Budget. 19 States responded and nominated nodal officers. Thus far, two states namely Kerala and Punjab have prepared the R&D Budget.

In order to accelerate the process of preparation of State R&D Budget, I am seeking your kind co-operation in taking necessary steps towards preparation of R&D State Budget from the FY 2026-2027 onwards.

As a first step, I request you to nominate afresh a nodal officer not below the rank of Joint Secretary to Government of India and share with us an updated status of the action taken by your Government towards preparation of separate R&D State Budget. The names of the nodal officers so nominated by you may be sent to Shri B. N. Satpathy, PSA Fellow (Email: bns6@rediffmail.com) with a copy to Shri Vivek Kumar at (Email: vivek.jist@psa.gov.in) by 31st December, 2025.

Dear Chief Secretary,

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) brings out an annual publication titled "State Finances: A Study of State Budgets". This report studies the fiscal position of State Governments on the basis of primary State level data. It also indicates expenditure trends on various items such as education, health and family welfare, science & technology, general administration etc.

2. This publication of RBI, however, does not give a detailed breakup of Research & Development (R&D) Expenditure incurred by State Governments. In view of this, the Office of Principal Scientific Adviser to Government of India (O/o PSA) requested RBI to study the R&D Expenditure trends by different States/UTs in detail and share its findings.

3. Accordingly, RBI conducted an exercise by culling out the R&D Expenditure data (State wise) from the Annual Financial Statements (AFS) of respective States. It identified the items of R&D related expenditure in the State Budgets where the word 'Research' (or 'अनुसंधान' if the budget is published in Hindi) appeared. The detailed methodology and caveats of this exercise conducted by RBI are mentioned in the attached study report.

4. The objective of sharing this study report is to impress on the State Government the need to prepare a separate State R&D Budget which not only captures the quantum but also the quality of R&D Expenditure across all respective State departments. This will enable each State Government to fix its R&D priorities at the time of preparation of the State budget. A similar practice has now been implemented by the Government of India by introducing a separate Appendix (LV) for capturing R&D Expenditure Data incurred by each Department/Ministry in Government of India vide para 13.12, page 22 of the Union Budget Circular 2021-22 (Link: <https://dea.gov.in/sites/default/files/Budget%20Circular%202021-2022.pdf>).

5. I look forward to receive your comments on the study report and also request you to nominate a senior Nodal Officer dealing with this subject of R&D to coordinate with O/o PSA for further correspondence in this regard. The nomination and comments may kindly be forwarded to Shri. B.N. Satpathy, Senior Consultant, O/o PSA (bn.satpathy@nic.in) with copy to Shri.
