



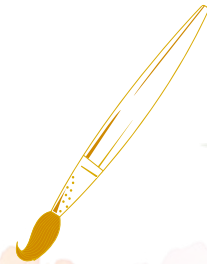

Subject: Report of the State Formation Day of Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Punjab and Tamil Nadu; and the Union Territory Formation Day of Andaman & Nicobar, Chandigarh, Delhi, Lakshadweep and Puducherry at Maharashtra Raj Bhavan Mumbai at 12 noon on 1st November 2023

Introduction:

As part of the 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' initiative of Government of India, Maharashtra Raj Bhavan has been celebrating the State Formation Days and Union Territory Formation Days of various States and Union Territories in India.

Under the guidance and leadership of the Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra Shri Ramesh Bais, the State Formation Day of Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Punjab, Tamil Nadu; and the Union Territory Formation Day of Andaman & Nicobar, Chandigarh, Delhi, Lakshadweep and Puducherry were celebrated at Maharashtra Raj Bhavan Mumbai at 12 noon on 1st November 2023.

Distinguished invitees drawn from a cross section of society and the staff and officers of Raj Bhavan attended the programme. The programme was held at the historic Darbar Hall of Raj Bhavan.

Organisers:

The State Formation Day of Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Punjab, Tamil Nadu; and the Union Territory Formation Day of Andaman & Nicobar, Chandigarh, Delhi, Lakshadweep and Puducherry were organised by Maharashtra Raj Bhavan in association with the Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University (BAMU), Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar (formerly Aurangabad) and the SNTD Women's University.

Programme Itinerary:

The programme started with the National Anthem, followed by the State Anthem of Maharashtra 'Jay Jay Maharashtra Majha, Garja Maharashtra Majha'.

This was followed by the welcome speech by Smt Shweta Singhal, Secretary to the Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra (In Charge). It was followed by a Cultural Presentation by the student artists of BAMU and SNTD Women's University.

The following items were presented: 1. Haryanvi Folk Dance 2. Punjabi Folk Dance (Giddha) 3. Mohini Attam Dance from Kerala 4. Karkattam (Tamil Nadu) 5. Patta Kunita (Karnataka) 6. Bhangra 7. Lakshadweep Dance (Kol Kali) 8. Puducherry Dance (Garadi). The dance programmes were interspersed with the screening of audiovisual films on Chandigarh, Lakshadweep, Delhi and Puducherry.



Remarks by the Hon'ble Governor:

Addressing the gathering, Governor Ramesh Bais said celebration of the foundation days of other states and Union Territories in the Raj Bhavans across the country has created awareness about the culture and traditions of other States, thereby strengthening the cause of unity and national integration.

The Governor said the foundation of four dharma peethas by Adi Shankaracharya in different corners of the country united the nation from Kashmir to Kanyakumari through the bonds of shared culture.
