CELEBRATION OF GOA AND TELANGANA STATE FOUNDATION DAY

INTRODUCTION:

As part of the 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' initiative of Government of India, Maharashtra Raj Bhavan has been celebrating the State Foundation Days and Union Territory Foundation Days of various States and Union Territories in India.

Under the guidance and leadership of the Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra Shri C P Radhakrishnan, the State Foundation Day of Goa (30 May) and Telangana (2 June) were celebrated on a single day, at Raj Bhavan Mumbai on 30 May 2025.

ORGANISERS:

The Goa State Foundation Day was organised by Maharashtra Raj Bhavan in association with the Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University (SRTMU), Nanded, while the Telangana State Foundation Day was organised in collaboration with the Mumbai Andhra Mahasabha and Gymkhana, a socio-cultural organisation of the people of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh based in Mumbai.

PROGRAMME ITINERARY:

The programme started with the Lighting of the Lamp followed by the National Anthem and the State Song of Maharashtra 'Jai Jai Maharashtra Majha, Garja Maharashtra Majha'.

This was followed by the welcome speech by Dr Prashant Narnaware, Secretary to the Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra.

The programme began with the presentation of an Audio Visual film depicting the life, history and heritage of Goa.

The stage was set for the cultural presentation by the artists and students of SRTMU. Boys and Girl Students of the SRTMU presented the Dhalo traditional folk song and dance of Goa.

It was followed by the Diwali dance by girls carrying lamps on their head.

The second part began with the recitation of the State Song of Telangana. It was followed by the traditional Bathukamma Dance by the women members of the Mumbai Andhra Sabha and Gymkhana.

This was followed by the presentation of Shiv Natya Hela by Kuchipudi exponent Natya Siromani Nadiya. The dance mesmerised the entire audience.

I am proud to say that the Telugu-speaking community in Maharashtra not only celebrates its own festivals like Ugadi, Sankranti, Bathukamma, and Bonalu, but also celebrates Maharashtra's festivals.

Many people speak both Telugu and Marathi with equal love and pride.

I am happy that many cultural associations from Goa and Telangana are doing great work and enriching the culture of Maharashtra.

Today, Goa and Telangana are playing an important role in achieving the dream of a 'Viksit Bharat' - a developed India.

Let us all promise to keep building stronger bonds, and to work together for an inclusive, strong, and united India.

Once again, I congratulate the artists and students of Swami Ramananda Teerth Marathwada University for their fantastic performance and wish you success in your future endeavours.

sive depth.

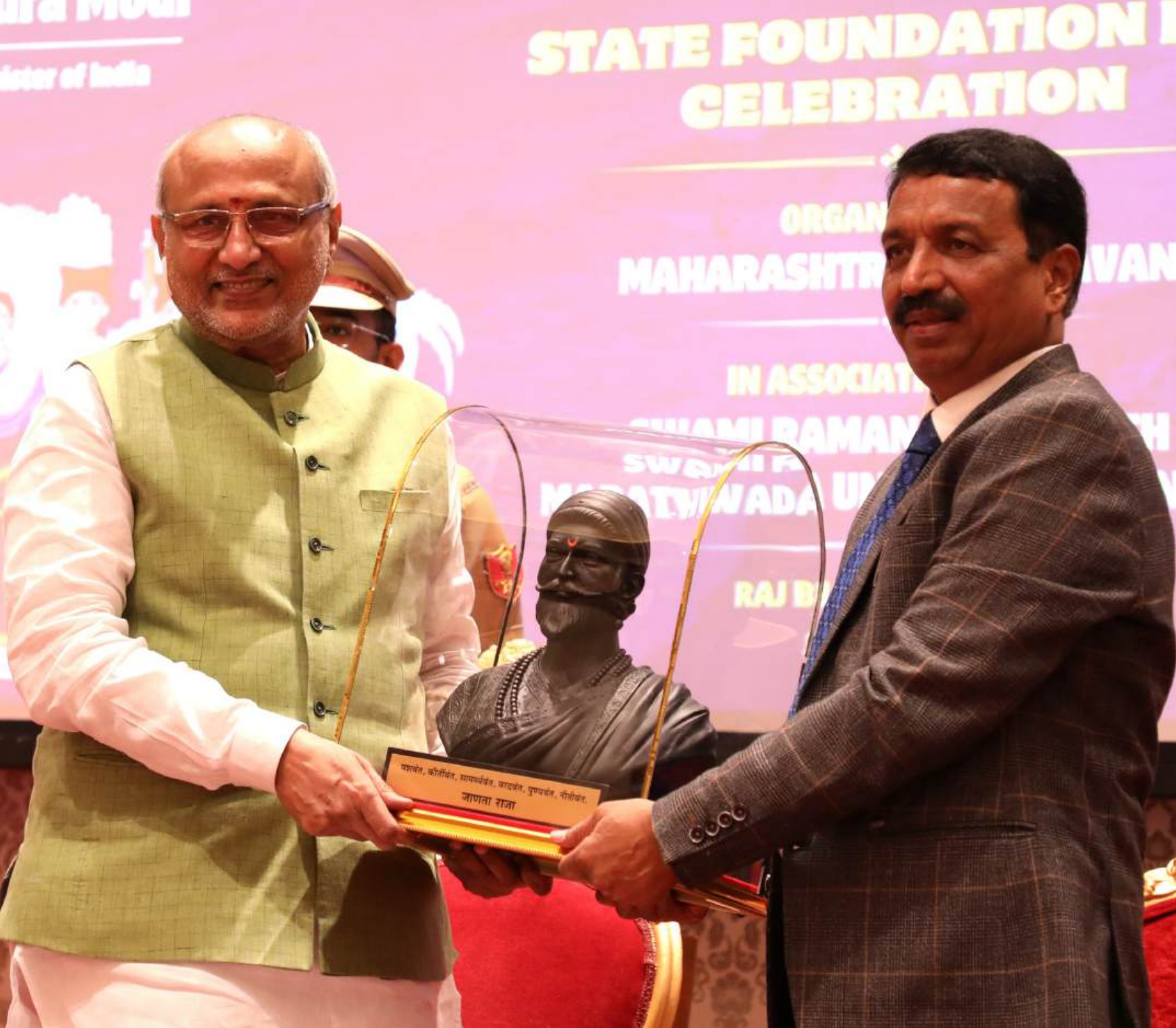
