CIRCULAR

Empanelment of Legal Consultant(s) in the Law Commission of India, Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India, Lok Nayak Bhavan, 'B' Wing, 2nd and 4th Floor, Khan Market, New Delhi-110003.

The Law Commission intends to prepare a panel of Legal Consultants to assist the Commission in its broad based research work on the projects in hand. From the panel, the Law Commission will avail the services of suitable candidates by engaging them on the basis of their research skills and project related expertise, if any, which is relevant to the terms of reference of the present Law Commission.

The Terms of Reference of the 22nd Law Commission, inter alia, includes review/repeal of obsolete laws, to examine the Laws which affect the poor and carry out post-audit for socio-economic legislations, to keep under review the system of judicial administration to ensure that it is responsive to the reasonable demands of the times and in particular to secure, to examine the existing laws in the light of Directive Principles of State Policy and to suggest ways of improvement and reform and also to suggest such legislations as might be necessary to implement the Directive Principles and to attain the objectives set out in the Preamble to the Constitution, examine the existing laws with a view for promoting gender equality and suggesting amendments thereto, to revise the Central Acts of general importance so as to simplify them and to remove anomalies, ambiguities and inequities, to examine the impact of globalization on food security, unemployment and recommend measures for the protection of the interests of the marginalized.

2. Terms and conditions for engagement as Legal Consultant:

- (i) Legal Consultants will be paid an honorarium of Rs. **75,000/** per month (Fixed).
- (ii) The headquarters of the Consultants shall be at the Law Commission of India, New Delhi.
- (iii) In case the information furnished by the applicant is found to be false at any stage, the same will invite disqualification and/or action as deemed appropriate by the Law Commission of India, whose decision shall be final and binding.
