### **ABOUT COURSE:**

To accurately translate spoken language into Indian Sign Language, the interpreter must have a solid understanding of the subject matter being discussed. Indian Sign Language interpreters may be present during office meetings, court proceedings, or political speeches. They can also facilitate communication in one-on-one situations between two parties.

Additionally, interpreters might utilize technology to provide remote services. Key responsibilities of an interpreter include strong listening, sign language, and communication skills. When dealing with highly technical or complex information, an interpreter may need to conduct research to fully understand the content being interpreted. A good memory is also essential, as the interpreter must remember what has been said in order to convey it accurately through sign language.

### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

A candidate should have:

- a) Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks
- b) Functional hands
- c) Fluency in at least one language
- d) Hearing within the normal range
