PROSPECTUS

1.0 INTRODUCTION:

The National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (NIEPID, Divyangjan) formerly known as National Institute for the Mentally Handicapped is a registered society established in the year 1984 as an autonomous body under the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. The Institute is an apex body having tripartite functions of training, research and services in the field of Intellectual Disability in the country. For 41 years, the Institute has been making significant advances in building capacities to empower Persons with Intellectual Disability.

Based on the latest developments and recent trends in the field, the Institute strives to organize new programmes and make innovations through research and development. National and International collaborations entered into by the Institute in its various activities reflect the global characteristics of the organization. The activities of NIEPID are planned in accordance with the mandates of United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD), the Legislative Acts and the National Policy promulgated for the Persons with Disabilities.

NIEPID strives to be an Institute of excellence focusing on high standards in every aspect of its functioning to bring equality and dignity in the lives of Persons with Intellectual Disability which is endorsed by ISO 9001: 2015 certification.

1.2 SHORT TERM PROGRAMMES:

Various training programmes, Workshops, Seminars and Diagnostic Camps are conducted in the field of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities in the States of Maharashtra, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Goa and Union Territories of Diu, Daman and Dadra & Nagar Haveli.

1.3 SERVICE ACTIVITIES:

Services in Assessment and Intervention are provided at the NIEPID RC, Navi Mumbai for persons with Intellectual Disabilities in the areas of Special Education, Psychological Assessment, Occupational Therapy, Speech therapy, Physiotherapy, Vocational; Training, Guidance and Counseling etc. Persons coming from outstation are assessed.

2.0 OVERALL AIMS & GENERAL OBJECTIVES of M.Ed SE (ID) Course:

2.1 AIM:

The aim of the M. Ed. Spl. Ed. (ID) programme is of preparing teachers as education leaders. The major thrust of the M. Ed. Spl. Ed. (ID) programme would be professional preparation of teacher educators who would through this process be equipped with the knowledge and competencies to facilitate and conduct initial preparation and continuing professional development of teachers. They would need to be necessarily equipped with the core competencies and knowledge related to teacher education, its philosophical underpinnings, research methodology, curriculum planning and be aware of best practices in the field of pedagogical interventions and adaptations for children with intellectual disabilities.

2.2 GENERAL OBJECTIVES:-

The M. Ed. Spl. Ed. (ID) program supports three shared philosophical stances underlying longstanding tradition of preparing teacher educators as education leaders. These stances include teaching as inquiry, teaching as curriculum making and teaching for social justice. The objectives of the program are to:

- Assist potential teacher educators to exert leadership in advocating and meeting educational needs of children with disabilities in various settings
- Offer special teacher educators the opportunity to develop specialized capacity for leadership in curriculum, pedagogy and universal design
- Build theoretical knowledge and skills in research methodologies and conducting research in order to enhance education of children with intellectual disabilities in all settings.

PLACEMENT OPPORTUNITIES TO WORK AS TEACHER EDUCATOR/ ADMINISTRATOR/ RESEARCHER: -

- In teacher-education colleges in Special Education (Intellectual Disability)
- In research projects funded by government/non-government organizations in the field of disability rehabilitation
- In regular/inclusive schools.
- Rehabilitation clinics.
- Community Based Rehabilitation programs.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY: -

A candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed. Special Education (MR/ID) regular/distance mode from a recognized University or any other degree equivalent from an affiliating University and/ or Teaching Department under any University recognized by U.G.C. and RCI with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.

OR

A candidate who has successfully passed the B.Ed. (General Education) with minimum 50% aggregate and has successfully completed Diploma in Special Education (Mental Retardation/Intellectual Disability) or equivalent recognized by the RCI with minimum 50% aggregate marks.

OR

A candidate who has successfully passed the Integrated BA/B. Sc/B. Com & B.Ed Special Education recognized by the RCI with minimum 50% aggregate marks

For Foreign Nationals

1. 15% of the total intake approved by the Council to be allocated as supernumerary seats for management quota for all the above said programmes.
2. 15% of the total intake approved by the Council to be allocated as supernumerary seats for foreign/ NRI quota. The fee structures for foreign students are as under.
 - I. Fee for Indian national – at the existing fee rate.
 - II. Foreign national from the SAARC and African countries – Five times of the existing fees.
 - III. Foreign nationals outside the SAARC countries – Fifteen times of the existing fees

5.0 SELECTION: -

Admission is given on the basis of the merit obtained by the candidates in the entrance examination and followed by counseling/interview conducted as per the rules and regulations of University of Mumbai.

5.1 ENTRANCE EXAMINATION:

The Entrance examination will be conducted at above address.

The total marks for the entrance examination will be 100 and the duration of the examination will be of 90 minutes. The questions will be objective type, covering

- (i) General Mental Ability,
- (ii) General Knowledge,
- (iii) General English,
- (iv) Broad aspects of general education and special education.

Selection will be made in the order of merit.

In case a candidate is appearing or has appeared in the qualifying examination and results are awaited at the time of applying, he/she would submit a certificate to this effect from the Principal/Head of the college but he/she shall have to provide documentary evidence of his/her having passed the qualifying examination with attested photocopy of the marks sheet showing percentage of marks obtained by him/her at the time of admission latest by failing which his/her performance in the Entrance Examination will not be considered.

5.2 COUNSELING:-

All candidates in merit list must attend counseling on given date.

The admission made is provisional subject to approval by the University of Mumbai regarding the recognition of the qualifying examination, submission of Transfer Certificate and Migration Certificate.

HEALTH:

Candidates are required to declare their health status in the application in case of pregnancy, infectious diseases, chronic health problems or suffering from any psychiatric problem. If the candidate is unable to complete course requirement due to health problems then NIEPID reserves the right for termination from admission to M.Ed Spl.Edn.(ID).

NUMBER OF SEATS:

The total number of seats will be 15 (Fifteen). Reservation will be applied as per the rules of Government of India (Reservation for PH – Persons having disability only in lower limbs without reverse limitations in mobility may be considered for this category).

DURATION OF THE COURSE : 2 years

The Course/programme will be of 4 Semesters (two years) with 2 semesters in each year. Each semester will be of 16-18 weeks; 2 weeks in summer and 2 weeks in inter semester break will also be utilized for covering the courses. In this way, the following operational weeks will be available for transacting the course:

Year 1- 16-18 weeks for each of the two semesters + 2 weeks in summer

Year 2- 16-18 weeks for each of the two semesters + 2 weeks in inter-semester breaks

No admission/readmission are to be made after the expiry of four weeks from the date of commencement of instruction. In case there are any court cases consequent on which the Convener of admissions is compelled to admit any candidate after the last date of admission, the admission (seat) of such a student be reserved for the subsequent year on supernumerary basis.

Supplementary or any other examination (except internal tests) shall be conducted during the instruction period of the semester.

A candidate admitted to M.Ed Special Education (Intellectual Disability) course will forfeit seat and admission stands cancelled if;

- He/she does not put in at least 40% of the attendance in Semester – I.
- OR
- He/she does not secure promotion to Semester-II within a maximum period of two academic years starting from the year of admission. The same system will be applicable for semester III and IV.

OR

- He/she fails to fulfil all the requirements for the award of the degree as specified, within two academic years from the time of admission.

7.0 AWARD OF CERTIFICATE:

M. Ed. in Special Education (Intellectual Disability) issued by Mumbai University.

8.0 ATTENDANCE:

The programme will be conducted for at least 200 working days each year exclusive of the period of examination and admission. Physical presence in the institution of all the teachers and student teachers is necessary to ensure their availability for advice, guidance, dialogue and consultation as and when needed.

Students must maintain a minimum of 80% attendance in theory classes, with a condonation of up to 10% allowed for certified ill-health and up to 15% for pregnant women; for practical sessions, 90% attendance is mandatory without exception.

Attendance at NCC/NSS Camps or Inter-Collegiate or inter-University or Inter-State or National or International Matches or Debates, Youth Festivals or Educational Excursions if they form part of the curriculum of such other Inter-University, Inter-College activities as approved by the University will not be counted as absence. However the aggregate of all such absences should not exceed four weeks in a semester.

In any semester of the M.Ed Special Education (ID) course, if a candidate fails to secure the minimum percentage of attendance, he/she shall not be eligible to appear in the examination of that semester and he/she shall have to enroll himself/herself to undergo afresh a Regular Course of Study of the corresponding semester in a subsequent academic session in order to become eligible to appear for the examination.

Attendance shall be reckoned from the date of commencement of instruction as per the almanac communicated by the College/University. However, in the case of late admitted candidates (but within the stipulated time), the attendance will be reckoned from the date of admission.

To enable the students to know their attendance, at the end of each month the concerned Heads of Departments shall display cumulative attendance for information

8.0 AGE:

While no minimum and maximum age is prescribed, preference will be given to those below 35 years of age.

9.0 MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION AND EXAMINATION:

The medium of Instruction will be English however examination will be allowed to write in English/Marathi/Hindi.

COURSE STRUCTURE:

11.0 FEES:

The course fee will be charged as prescribed by the Mumbai University, Mumbai and the National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (Formerly National Institute for the Mentally Handicapped- NIMH) Regional Centre, Navi Mumbai.

12.0 HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION:

The shared hostel accommodation to outstation candidates is available on approved rates at NIEPID, Regional Centre Navi Mumbai Sector 05, Kharghar, Navi Mumbai subject to availability on **first-come-first- served basis**. The trainees will have to bear the expense on food

13.0 SCHOLARSHIP: -

NIEPID RC Navi Mumbai students are eligible to apply for various scholarships through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP), subject to the eligibility criteria of their course and category

- Top Class Education Scholarship for SC/ST and PwD students
- Central Sector Scholarship
- National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST students
- Central Sector Scheme of Scholarships for UG and PG courses
- PM YASASVI Central Sector Scheme for OBC, EBC, and DNT students
- Post-Matric Scholarship for all courses

Students from Maharashtra State can apply for the Maharashtra State Scholarship for OBC, SC, and ST categories. Additionally, students can apply for education loans under the PM Vidya Lakshmi Scheme, with institutional support and guarantee provided by NIEPID RC Navi Mumbai.

NOTE:-

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE: - Candidates admitted in the course have to submit Eligibility Certificate from University of Mumbai (students from other than University of Mumbai) within 15 days from date of joining. If the candidate fails to submit the same, the admission will be cancelled duly forfeiting the amount paid by them.

- Original certificates deposited will not be released during the course and students are advised to keep sufficient number of photo copies before submission of original certificates to office at the time of admission.
- Procedure for acquiring bonafide certificate: Bonafide certificate will be provided if the student applies for the same to the Incharge, Academics

The candidate once admitted in the course will not be allowed to leave the course under any circumstances. If the candidate still desires to leave the course for any reason, the total fee and deposits paid by the candidate will be forfeited.

16.0 DISCIPLINE:

The candidates admitted shall be subjected to strict discipline inside and outside the campus and also in the hostel where accommodation is provided. 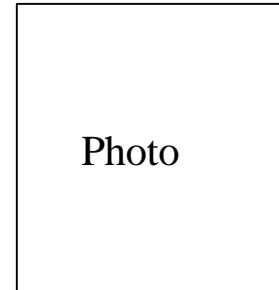
