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About NIEPID

National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities is an autonomous body under the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. The primary objectives of Institute are to promote a) human resource development b) research and development in the field of Intellectual Disability. Rehabilitation services for PwID demand multidisciplinary approach for equipping skills and competencies among the persons with intellectual disabilities for independent living and full participation in the society. What is this Conference?

Inclusive Vocational Rehabilitation is an approach seeking to address the training needs of all youth, adults with specific focus on those who are vulnerable to marginalization and exclusion. Access and Quality at Salamanca, 1994. It was reemphasized and elaborated in the UNCRPD 2006 in which India was one of the member countries to ratify. Chapter IV of RPwD Act emphasized on Skill Development and Employment for vocational rehabilitation of PwDs. Inclusion of person with disability in all mainstream formal and non-formal vocational and skill training schemes and programmes needs to be improved for quality of adult independent living.













The key objective of RTE is universalization of elementary education which emphasized on access, enrolment and retention of all children in 6 to 14 years of age. This goal has been further facilitated by the 86th amendment of the Constitution, making free and compulsory elementary education a fundamental Right for all the children with special needs. With this, the concept of inclusive education has been popularized in the education system. With the enactment of RPwD Act, 2016 a legal status has been ascribed to inclusive education and the emphasis is given on the fact that no child can be denied admission in the neighborhood schools on the ground of disability.

NIEPID in collaboration with the Federation of Vocational Rehabilitation Professionals (FVRP) is a national collective of experts dedicated to empowering persons with disabilities and marginalized groups through skill-based training, employment, and inclusive community participation. Registered under Section 8 of the Companies Act, FVRP promotes ethical, evidence-based vocational rehabilitation practices by uniting professionals with recognised national and international qualifications. Through collaboration, advocacy, and capacity building, FVRP drives policy reform and professional excellence to ensure dignified livelihoods for all.

It is aimed to equip the teachers with knowledge and skills in inclusive training. The focus will also be on orienting the teachers with the inclusive practices to enable them to teach adults with special needs in inclusive classroom.


