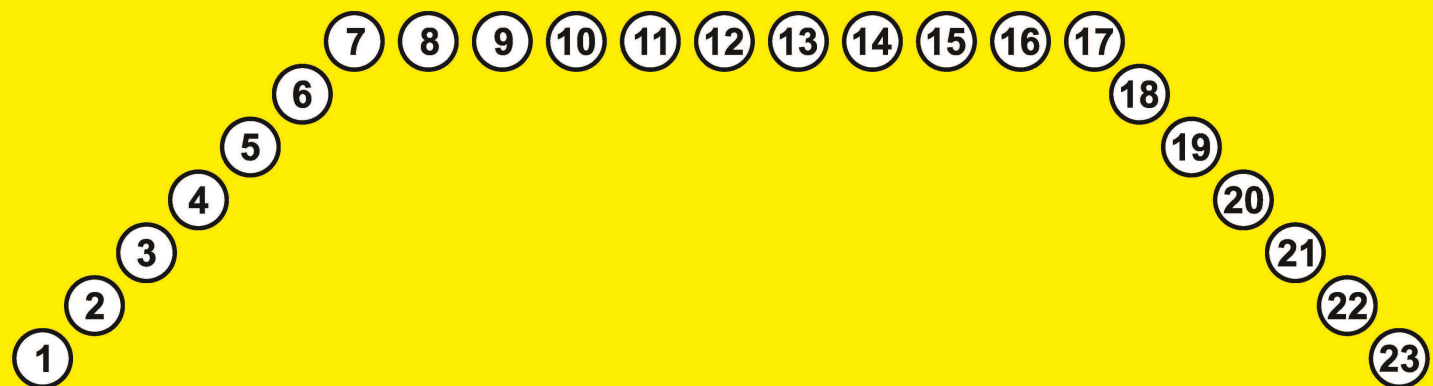

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HOW TO USE THIS FOLDER?

Turn the page. You will see a special calendar for your child.
You can hang it on the wall. It is a lesson for your child for 365 days.
Child should be taught to tell the days, months and numbers 1 to 31 in order as the first step.
Every morning ask your child "what day is today? give him a paper clip and tell him to keep the clip against the day.
The same way ask him the date and month, give him two more clips to keep against the date and month.
Follow it daily, you will see that your child is learning the day, date and month.
Now you may ask a question, "my child does not know how to read the day, date and month. What to do ?
There is a way to teach Let's see how.



HOW TO TEACH THE DAYS OF WEEK?

- Teach the child to say the names of days in order.
- Teach him to read the days in order.
- Give different types of calendars and tell him to read the days.
- Ask him to show a particular day on a calendar.
- In case your child tells the names of days in order and fails to read a particular day. For ex : Wednesday, try the following method.
- First show him where is sunday and keep his finger on Sunday.
- Tell him to move his finger to Monday, Tuesday, then Wednesday. He can find any day using this method.

HOW TO TEACH READING MONTH?

- Teach the child to say the numbers in order.
- Teach him to read the day in order.
- Give him different types of calendars and tell him to read the months.
- Ask him to point to a particular month.
- Give flash cards and tell him to keep them in order.
- In case your child says the months in order and fails to read a particular month, show him where January is and follow the same method like teaching 'Wednesday'.

- First teach your child to count 1 to 30 in order.
- After learning upto 10 continue from 11 to 20 then follow it upto 31
- Give him different calendars and ask him to read upto 31
- You can give him number cards to match with.
- In case your child counts upto 31 and fails to read a particular number show him number '1' and ask him to place his finger on '1' and move to the particular number one by one.
