

NIEPID Indian Test of Intelligence is an indigenous test developed to measure IQ in Indian Children between the age of 3 to 18 years. The test is based on five factor model, namely Knowledge, Fluid Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, Visual Spatial Reasoning and Working Memory. This test will contribute to a more widespread and new informed knowledge of understanding and solving problems of identification and assessment of persons with Intellectual difficulties and provide positive steps to improve their quality of life. The tool will be used for issuance of disability certificate for persons with Intellectual disability so that they can accrue the social benefits and concessions given by Government of India.
