Subject: Biennial Elections to the Council of States from Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand and Bye Election to the Council of States from West Bengal-reg.

The terms of office of 11 members of the Council of States (Rajya Sabha) from Uttar Pradesh (10 seats) and Uttarakhand (1 seat) are going to expire in the month of November, 2026, as detailed in Annexure 'A'.
