NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (2) of Section -12 of Panchkula Metropolitan Development Authority Act, 2021, I, Ajit Balaji Joshi, IAS, Chief Executive Officer, Panchkula Metropolitan Development Authority, Panchkula do hereby delegate powers regarding allotment of tenders and issue of work orders for execution of infrastructure projects by contract to the officers of Panchkula Metropolitan Development Authority to the extent and limits as specified herein below :-
