No. F-9(7)/RG/UERC/2008/1125 - In exercise of powers conferred under section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, and after previous publication, the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following regulations to amend the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations, 2004 (Principal Regulations), namely:

**1. Short Title, Commencement and Interpretation**

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2008.
- (2) These shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

**2. In Appendix 2 of the Principal Regulations:**

- (1) at the end of clause (7), the following shall be added, namely:-

“(8) If the outage of any element causes power cut in the area of supply of the distribution licensee, then the outage period for that element shall be deemed to be twice the actual outage period for that day(s) on which such power cut has taken place.
- (9) In case of delay in commissioning of any transmission element beyond the scheduled date given while getting investment plan approved from the Commission, the transmission element shall be deemed to be

commissioned from such date and shall be considered to be unavailable due to forced outage for the purpose of calculating the overall availability of the transmission system.”

Provided that in exceptional Force Majeure cases where the licensee produces evidence/reasons to the satisfaction of the Commission that the delay was for reasons beyond its control the delay may be condoned by the Commission to the extent deemed fit by it.

(10) The SLDC shall maintain the month-wise information on the availability of the transmission lines in the format to be issued by the Commission separately. The SLDC shall submit this information to the Commission and the transmission and distribution licensees within 7 days of the end of each month.
