Date of Order: 23rd April 2010

A hearing on the above matter was held at Nainital in which GM (Kumaon

Zone), DGM, Ranikhet and SDO, Munsiyari were present. The contents of the

complaint were read out by the Chairman, UERC including those regarding

allegations of un-authorised extraction of money from the complainant. The SDO

present denied all these allegations except that he submitted that on request of the

consumer, he checked the connected load of consumer's installation which was found

to be 55 kW and accordingly advised the consumer to get his load enhanced to 50 kW.

It was also stated that the consumer insisted on getting the load enhanced only upto

15 kW and, hence, said complaint has been lodged. As per Regulation 1.2 (1) (m) of

the UERC (The Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2007, connected load can be

used only for the purpose of assessment in case of theft of energy or unauthorised use

of energy.

It was also confirmed by the SDO that the consumer has electronic meter,

which is capable of recording MDI. From the copy of bills presented during the

hearing, it was noticed that in violation of clause 10 of "General Conditions of

Supply" in the approved rate schedule applicable for non-domestic consumers,

neither the MDI of the consumer was reflected in the bill nor the excess load penalty

was being levied as per the said clause.

In this regard, the licensee is directed to:

- 1. Get the case investigated by its vigilance department and submit a report thereon within 15 days of issuance of this order.
- 2. To show cause why an action should not be taken against the licensee for violating the provisions of Regulation & Tariff Order and not including the excess load penalty based on MDI reading for non-domestic consumers as in the above case within 15 days of issuance of this order.
