UTTARANCHAL ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

ORDER

Some discrepancies in accounting of substantial surpluses accruing to

Uttaranchal Power Corporation Ltd. (UPCL) on account of various reasons,

including evasion of Regulatory scrutiny, had come to Commission's notice.

The Commission had therefore requested the State Government on 19.04.2005

to have the matter inquired in to. This was followed with a reminder sent on

29th June, 2005. When no response was received to the above request the

Commission decided to take cognizance and get the matter investigated

under section 128 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and passed an order to this effect

on 28th November 2005. A copy of the said order is enclosed herewith. M/s

Amit Ray & Company, a firm of professional auditors, was selected for

undertaking this investigation and have already taken up the work and their

report is expected very soon.

2. While the statutory investigation in the matter is already under way.

The Commission has now received a copy of Government's O&M dated

07.03.06 constituting an enquiry committee. It is to be ensured that the

ongoing investigation under section 128 of the Electricity Act, 2003 should not

get adversely affected by any action of the above committee. Accordingly, the

Commission hereby directs the committee and its member u/s 94(2) of the

Electricity Act, 2003 to ensure that no action of the Committee or of its

members obstructs, delays, hampers or in any other way jeopardises the

ongoing statutory investigation.
