This is with reference to Hon'ble Commission's letter no. UERC/6/TF-758/2024-25/2024/1289, dated 30-12-2024 vide which the petitioner has been asked to submit the reply to the deficiencies/ shortcomings as shown at Annexure -B of the letter and observed by the Hon'ble Multi Year Tariff (MYT) Petition for the Control Period of Three Financial Years From FY 2025-26 To FY 2027-28 alongwith Tariff Determination for FY 2025-26, truing-up for FY 2023-24 and Annual Performance Review For FY 2024-25. The petitioner is directed to submit the reply on the affidavit. The point wise reply/ information is mentioned herein below and the petitioner most respectfully showeth as follows in the matter:

A. True up of FY 2023-24

1. UPCL should submit all the relevant information along with the supporting documents for substantiating the actual expenses incurred on account of Water Tax for FY 2023-24.

Reply:

The Petitioner humbly submits the summary of the expense incurred on account of water Tax for FY 2023-24 as follows:

3. UPCL should submit audited commercial diary (CS-3 and CS-4) (division wise and consolidated)along with consolidated statements and COMDATA for FY 2023-24.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits the audited commercial diary wherein the division wise, circle wise, zone wise and consolidated of total UPCL figures are included alongwith COMDATA for FY 2023-24 as Annexure C in soft copy.

- 4. UPCL should submit the details of actual expenses incurred duly substantiated by the vouchers for expenses incurred in maintaining the 33/11 KV S/s, 11/0.415 KV S/s, 33 KV line and 11 KV line for the following divisions of UPCL (2 from each of the respective division).
 - i) Dehradun(Urban).
 - ii) Dehradun (Rural).
 - iii) Haridwar.
 - iv) Nainital.
 - v) Rudrapur I.
 - vi) Rudrapur II.

UPCL is also required to submit the details of tenders floated for the aforesaid works along with a copy of the executive contract for awarding work to the successful bidder.

Reply:

The Petitioner humbly submits that the collection of information from divisions is under process and same will be submitted for Hon'ble Commission perusal by 31st January 2025. The Petitioner respectfully seek relief from Hon'ble Commission till 31st January 2025.

5. UPCL should submit the break-up of capitalisation done in FY 2023-24 into HT works, LT Works and other works.

Reply:

The Petitioner humbly submits that the net capitalization as per the books of accounts is Rs 797.81 Crores (Total additions of Rs 838.62 Cr. Minus deductions of Rs 40.81 Cr) and capitalization under "Plant and machinery" and Lines & cables as per book of accounts is Rs 804.62 Cr which pertains to HT & LT works. The table below represents the amount against which the electrical inspector certificates are submitted to Hon'ble UERC:

7. It is observed that under Mixed Load category, the number of consumers has increased whereas consumption and contracted demand has decreased. UPCL is required to submit the reason for the same.

Reply:

The Petitioner humbly submits that in mixed load category number of consumers increased from 85 to 89, however, load has been decreased by 337 KW and sales by 0.54 MU. The change in consumer numbers is in following divisions:

8. The Petitioner at Table 9 of the Petition has shown details of actual sales vis-a-vis approved sales for FY 2023-24 wherein it is observed that the actual sales for almost all the category of consumers is lower than the approved sales for FY 2023-24, except Non-Domestic consumers. Further, major deviation has been observed in the Industrial category of consumers. In this regard, UPCL is required to submit its own analysis for the reason of variance and also quantify how much of the same pertains to load shedding by the corporation, if any.

Reply:

The Petitioner humbly submits that consumer category wise sales during FY 2023-24 is as below:

The energy sales recorded by the Petitioner in FY 2023-24 have been 13,870.70 MUs which is 2.81% higher than the sales recorded in the previous FY 2022-23 (13,491.23 MU). However, from the table above it has been observed that except for non-domestic, sales in all the categories are lower than anticipated in TO for FY2023-24. Themajor impact is on Industry sales, especially on HT industry i.e. 686 Mus followed by Domestic category i.e. 265.1 MUs.For TO of FY 2023-24, the Commission has considered the growth rate of 5% for both LT Industry and HT Industry and for Domestic Category the growth rate has been considered as 5 Year CAGR of 6.31%. Further, the Petitioner humbly submits that UPCL has been making consistent efforts to provide uninterrupted power supply to its consumers.

The load shedding in FY 2023-24 is of 114.09 MUs and has been mainly due to following reasons:

- 1. On SLDC's instructions to control drawal.
- 2. Due to outage in Transmission network.
- 3. Due to transmission constraints in Transmission Licensee's network. It is also to mention that scheduled power cuts are being imposed and rostering is being done only due to emergency breakdown/shutdowns. Supply hours in Urban feeders has increased to 23:41 hrs/day in FY 2023-24 from 23:36 hours/ day in FY 2022-23 and in Rural feeders has increased to 23:28 hrs/day in FY 2023-24 from 23:15 hrs/ day in FY 2022-23.
- 9. The Petitioner is required to submit as to why the GFA value of Rs. 550.18 Crore has been considered in the total GFA for FY 2023-24 when UPCL has not claimed the impact of transfer scheme.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that transfer scheme between UPPCL and UPCL for division of assets and liabilities was executed on 12-10-2003. As per the transfer









scheme, the Gross Fixed Assets (GFA) amounting to Rs. 1058.18 Cr. were transferred to UPCL but Hon'ble UERC considered the value of opening GFA as Rs. 508 Cr. only and has been allowing returns on equity, depreciation and interest on loan on the said amount.

In the absence of notification of transfer scheme by the Government of Uttarakhand, Hon'ble UERC did not consider the balance value of GFA i.e. Rs. 550.18 Cr. (Rs. 1058.18 Cr. – Rs. 508.00 Cr.) till the notification of the same from GoU. On the request of UPCL, GoU vide its order dated 08-03-2022 notified the above scheme for transfer of assets and liabilities executed between UPPCL and UPCL. As GoU has now notified the said scheme, the Petitioner has now worked out its various claims on the basis of notified Transfer Scheme from 12-10-2003.

However, the impact of transfer scheme is not being claimed in the ARR and Tariff Petition. The petitioner vide its letter no. 7868/MD/UPCL/R-14, dated 5.12.2024has requested M/s Power Finance Corporation (nodal agency of RDSS appointed by MoP, GoI), for allowing UPCL for proposing the creation of Regulatory Assets against the pending claim of transfer scheme arose for the period from 12.10.2003 to 31.3.2023. On receipt of clarification further action shall be taken by UPCL in the matter.

Further it is humbly submitted that while past impact (along with revenue gap) is not claimed in the ARR, to prevent further build-up of the revenue gap and to avoid any future carrying cost due to disallowance, the GFA of value of Rs. 550.18 Crore has been added in total GFA base of FY 2023-24.

Considering the same, the Petitioner humbly requests the commission to consider the GFA as per the Audited Accounts of FY 2023-24.

10. What are the other charges paid to the generating stations during FY 2023-24 as reflected in Form 2.9.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that the other charges paid to the generating stations during FY 2023-24containsany charges/arrears except on account of Fixed and variable charge such as Water Tax, Cess, Royalty, incentives, deferred tax liability etc.

11. Why salaries for apprentices have gone up by Rs. 1.05 Crore in FY 23 to Rs. 2.24 Crore in FY 24. (Form 4.1)

12. DPS on Government consumers for FY 2023-24 should be furnished failing which the Commission would work out the same based on the principles adopted for truing up for FY 2022-23.

Reply:

The petitioner submits that in the matter that as per the Policy of Government of Uttarakhand, no interest/DPS is payable by UPCL on the dues payable to GoU and by GoU on the dues payable to UPCL. In this connection, Minutes of Meeting held on 15.10.2012 in the Chamber of Secretary Finance, GoU along with the petitioner's O.M. no – 152/UPCL/RM/K-3, dated 16.01.2023 is attached in **Annexure E**. Therefore, logic has been set in the billing system not to compute delayed payment surcharge on arrears from Govt. Categories and as per commercial diary, the DPS for government categories for FY 2023-24 is zero. The DPS can't be worked out now manually.

13. Details of apprentice and other training expenses of Rs. 58.88 Crore incurred in FY 2023-24 to be provided. (Form 4.1).

Reply:

The petitioner respectfully submits that there is an inadvertent typographical error. The cost incurred on apprentice salaries is Rs 2.24 Cr and is claimed under the sub-head of Employee's cost. the expense of Rs 58.88 Crores is related to Bonus, Medical reimbursement/expenses, electricity subsidy to employees, other welfares etc. the breakup of the same is as follows:

14. What is other staff cost of Rs. 118.71 Crore incurred in FY 2023-24. Details to be provided. (Form 4.1).

Reply:

The Petitioner humbly submits that Other Staff Costs Rs.118.71 Cr. comprises of payments to outsourced employees of Uttarakhand PurvSainik Kalyan Nigam Ltd., Self Help Groups and manpower supply through contractors.

15. UPCL is required to submit the reasons for increase in R&M expenses in FY 2023-24 towards Buildings by more than 100% and lines and cables by 35% (Form 4.2).

Reply:

The Petitioner humbly submits the reasons for increase in R&M expenses in FY 2023-24 towards Buildings and lines &cables as follows:

- Uttarakhand State is facing huge disasters every year which lead to reconstruction of infrastructures. During FY 2022-23 about Rs. 27 Crore was spent for reconstruction while it has increased to Rs. 34.22 Crore in FY 2023-24. So, an additional amount of Rs. 7.2 Crore has spent in year FY 2023-24 with respect to previous Financial year.
- UPCL has added 4350 nos. of distribution transformers, 42 Kms. 33 KV lines, 687 Km.
 11 KV lines and 1057 Km. LT lines to its distribution infrastructure in the FY 2023-24 due to which O&M cost has also increased on this account.
- 3. Repair cost of transformer has been booked by Store and Workshop divisions in R&M expense head(earlier booked under System Improvement Works) and also, cost of meters pertaining to replacement of IDF meters by Test Divisions has been booked in

- R&M exp. head. As a result, of which there is an increase of Rs. 44.22 Crore in FY 2023-24 in this head.
- 4. During FY 2022-23 BoD and Uttarakhand Shashan instructed to secure valuable assets/land assets of UPCL located across Uttarakhand state. In compliance of instructions some of the civil works for securing sub-stations, special maintenance of boundary walls, stores and offices were carried out in phased manner in FY 2022-23 and rest were carried out in FY 2023-24.

16. UPCL is required to submit the details of Fee and Subscriptions Books and Periodicals of Rs. 3.18 Crore incurred in FY 2023-24 (Form 4.3).

18. UPCL is required to submit the reason for considering Cost of Bandwidth, Data Centre and Facility Management over and above the normative AG expenses for FY 2023-24.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that the Hon'ble Commission based on the previous year's Orders is allowing Data Centre expenses and License Fees on actual basis. The observation of the Hon'ble Commission from the Order dated 27.02.2019 wherein the UERC fees and Data & FMS charges was allowed at actuals separately over and above inflationary increases as under. The relevant extract from the said Tariff Order is given below:

The Commission has considered the normative gross A&G expenses approved in the True-up of FY 2017-18 as the gross base A&G expenses. This normative opening gross A&G expenses have been escalated by the WPI inflation of 0.33% to arrive at A&G expenses for FY 2018-19. The gross A&G expenses so arrived at have been considered as the gross A&G expenses (A&Gn-1) for FY 2018-19. From FY 2019-20 onwards, the Commission has computed the normative A&G expenses in accordance with the Regulation 84(3) considering the WPI inflation of 0.33%. Further, the Commission has considered the actual capitalization rate of A&G expenses for FY 2017-18 to be the capitalization rate for each year of the third Control Period. In addition, the Commission has considered the license fee as Rs. 3.00 Crore for FY 2019-20, Rs. 3.25 Crore for FY 2020-21 and Rs. 3.50 Crore for FY 2021-22.

As regards the additional provisioning toward the new expenses proposed during each year of the control period towards the data center, the Commission agrees with the Petitioner that these expenses were not there in previous Control Period and hence, provisioning of these expenses needs to be allowed in addition to the A&G expenses approved based on previous years A&G expenses. Accordingly, the Commission has considered the provisioning of additional A&G expenses for data center as claimed by the Petitioner for each year of the third Control Period. However, the Commission would like to clarify that the actual expenses towards provisioning of such costs shall be considered upon Truing-up subject to prudence check and any expense found unreasonable or unwarranted may be disallowed and any savings in provisioning of these costs shall not be considered towards sharing of gains. Moreover, the Petitioner is directed to properly account for these provisions in appropriate heads of accounts."

26. The Petitioner has claimed equity considered in the transfer scheme of Rs. 165.05 Crore in calculating opening equity for FY 2023-24. Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that the gross fixed assets (GFA) amounting to Rs 1058.18 Cr were transferred to UPCL, but the Hon'ble commission considered the value of GFA as Rs 508 Cr and allowing return on equity, depreciation, and interest on loan on the said amount. The balance amount of Rs 550.18 Cr which was later notified by commission has been considered as opening GFA for calculation of impact of transfer scheme. As per the regulations, the opening equity is considered as 30% of the GFA which is 30% of 550.18 Cr. i.e. Rs 165.05 Cr.

It is pertinent to mention that a liability of Rs 572 Cr was transferred to the petitioner company against the power purchase dues on UPCPCL towards CPSUs. This amount has

been considered as part of equity in opening GFA for the calculation of ROE.

27. It is observed that in Table 31 under Section 2, the Petitioner has claimed delayed payment surcharge, additional surcharge, CSS and wheeling charges recovery, whereas under column "Actual as per Audited Accounts" the same is considered as nil. The Petitioner is required to submit the reason for the same.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that under the column "actual as per accounts" heads that are considered in note no. 22 (other income) of the audited accounts are specified. However, in view of methodology adopted by the Hon'ble Commission in the previous Orders for determination of non-tariff income, delayed payment surcharge, additional surcharge, CSS and wheeling charges recovery are specified under column "UPCL Claim for FY 23-24".

28. The Petitioner is required to provide justification for not considering the Deferred Income towards Govt. Grants & Consumer Contributions towards Cost of Capital Assets from NTI in Table 31 under Section 2.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that the Deferred Income towards Govt. Grants & Consumer Contributions towards Cost of Capital Assets of Rs. 316.12 Cr has been removed from the NTI and the same is adjusted from Depreciation.

29. UPCL is required to submit the reconciliation in the difference between the amount of grant approved and claimed for FY 2023-24 as shown in Table 26.

Reply:

With regard to the grants, the Petitioner humbly submits that there is a great difficulty in identifying the assets created out of grants and consumer contribution and corresponding depreciation to be charged as well as writing back of the same (in case of scrap) at the time of dismantling of such assets. UPCL submitted that the same has also been covered in the Capitalization Policy of UPCL approved by the Commission, wherein it has been mentioned that the linking of receipts of capital grant, consumer contribution and subsidy to the creation of fixed assets and charging depreciation/writing back proportionate amount is practically not possible. UPCL submitted that this has resulted in variance in the balance of the GFA as submitted in the past and the balance as submitted in the latest response. The Petitioner in the current tariff proceedings has continued with its earlier values of grant and has further submitted that as per the directions of the Commission the exercise of identification of such assets along with their source of

31. UPCL should submit the voltage-wise cost of supply for current year and FY 2023-24 and the cross-subsidy w.r.t. voltage wise cost of supply.

Reply:

The petitioner respectfully submits that presently the accurate voltage wise distribution losses cannot be computed by UPCL, hence the petitioner has considered the overall distribution losses. UERC Tariff Regulation, 2024 (Regulation 91), states that the average cost of supply shall be used as benchmark for determining the tariff in case of pending availability of the voltage wise information. We request Hon'ble Commission to consider our submission. Further, it is also submitted in the matter that the petitioner is in process to implement the RDSS scheme in which the smart metering (Feeder/DTR and Consumer) has to be done. Once the work of smart metering is completed, the voltage wise losses will be available with the petitioner.

3. UPCL should submit the reasons why loss trajectory should be considered as proposed by UPCL and not that already stipulated by the Commission as all the capex related expenses which should have led to loss reduction in past years have been approved by the Commission.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that the Hon'ble Commission has approved distribution losses trajectory till FY 2024-25 as 13.25% in FY 2023-24and 13.00% in FY 2024-25. In comparison to which UPCL has performed well in reducing its losses 13.89% in FY 2023-24, which is a significant reduction considering the difficult terrain and large-scale rural electrification as part of the implementation of various Central Government schemes. The petitioner respectfully submits that the Loss reduction below 15% is very difficult to achieve considering difficult terrain of Uttarakhand. Inspite of significant measures and prudent capital expenditure under various schemes, due to difficult terrain of Uttarakhand, UPCL has not been able to meet the distribution loss target. This has resulted in further financial loss as the Commission has been considering deemed revenue at the time of truing-up for respective years due to non-achievement of the loss target. The ongoing works of smart-metering under RDSS scheme will significantly reduce the losses after completion in the control period.

Hence, for the 5th Control Period, it is humbly requested that the Commission should consider the actual loss level for approval of distribution loss target for each year.

4. Status of capex and capitalisation proposed in Table 89 and preparedness of UPCL to capitalise the amount proposed.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that for works under RDSS and ADB tenders for several works has been awarded and work is ongoing. Further, RDSS works are to be carried out with grant from GoI and loans. Works under ADB scheme are planned through Grant from ADB, funds by GoU and lending from REC.

With respect to preparedness for executing the other works proposed, the petitioner would like to submit that as a general practice it approaches funding agencies/bank etc. for necessary funding in lumpsum manner for certain amount to be executed over a period of time. The equity contribution from the state government is also being sought in same manner based on the requirement and in the interim, the petitioner manages the funding through internal resources.

5. UPCL to submit how it proposes to meet its equity share in the capex as in Table 125 UPCL has proposed equity addition of Rs. 1264 Crore from FY 2024-25 to FY 2027-28.

Reply:

The petitioner humbly submits that the RDSS works are to be carried out with grant from GoI and loans. Apart from grant from ADB, works under ADB are planned through funds by GoU and lending from REC.

Further, for the other works the petitioner would like to submit that as a general practice the equity contribution from the state government is being sought in same manner based on the requirement and in the interim, the petitioner manages the funding through internal resources.

However, in the petition for calculation purpose of return of equity in Table 125, the petitioner has bifurcated the total assets additions after subtracting grants as per the regulation norms of 70:30 debt equity ratio.

The Petitioner humbly submits that:

- 1. The total expenses have increased due to the growing number of consumers, with more being transitioned to monthly billing. In the fiscal year 2025-26, in the consumer base under monthly billing is anticipated, which rise in expenditures. The implementation of smart meter readings has begun in the plains, but full coverage of identified consumers will take time. Until then, manual meter readings will continue in these areas. Additionally, smart metering is not planned for the hilly rural regions, where UPCL will begin monthly billing, replacing the current bi-monthly system. As a result, expenditures under the meter reading category will rise, and this increase has been proposed in the proposed expenditure.
- 2. In case of call center, the cost increased for the following Reason:
- a) Additional 8 Nos of Man Power.
- b) Monthly Cost for Approximately 3000 Sq Ft, as the call center building is to be shifted to rental premises due to increase in size.
- c) Other Rental cost for Infrastructure.
- d) 25 KVA Online UPS with batteries.

- f) 16 Channel DVR & CCTV Camera
- q) Head Phones, Supervisor Laptop

Furthermore, based on RDSS guidelines issued by MoP, special states such as

Rest of the expenditure is proposed to be met under TOTEX. Total 15,87,870 nos of consumer meter, 59,212 nos of DTR meter and 2602 nos. of feeder meter installation is planned.

Total proposed outlay towards smart metering works is to the tune of Rs 2027.02 Cr. and expenses of Rs 1779.56 Cr. after subtracting grant (Rs 247.46 Cr) is planned to be recovered in 10 years. The opex expanses during the control period on the basis of smart meter roll out plan is as follow:

8. Whether tariff subsidy to domestic consumers by GoU shall continue in FY 2025-26 also and if yes, the letter of GoU to this effect.

Reply:

Government of Uttarakhand vide its letter no. 630/I(2)/2024-06(3)-23/2024 dated 24.09.2024 has announced subsidy in electricity tariff of domestic category consumers with effective from 01.09.2024. Domestic category consumers in snow bound areas having monthly consumption upto 200 units will be provided 50 % subsidy on tariff including electricity duty. Other domestic consumers having connected load upto 1 kW and monthly consumption upto 100 units will be provided 50 % subsidy on tariff including electricity duty.

Any decision on the tariff subsidy in FY 2025-26 shall be reported to the Hon'ble Commission once it is received to the petitioner.

The Petitioner request Hon'ble Commission to determine full cost recovery tariff for the above category.

9. UPCL has proposed HT industrial tariff for LT industrial consumers having load upto 75 kW and uses demand exceeding 100 kVA in a month. - c) Expenditure incurred on major Renovation and Modernization of PPE resulting in increased life and/or efficiency of an existing asset, is added to the cost of the related asset. PPE acquired as replacement of the existing assets/ component are capitalized and its corresponding replaced assets/ component removed/ retired from active use are derecognized.
- d) An item of Property, Plant and Equipment's (PPE) is derecognized upon disposal or when no future economic benefits are expected from its use or disposal. Gains or losses arising from de-recognition of items of PPE are measured as the difference between the net disposal proceeds and the carrying amount of the asset and are recognized in the statement of profit and loss when the asset is derecognized.
- e) The company has chosen the cost (historical cost) model of recognition and this model is applied to an entire class of PPE. After recognition as an asset, an item of PPE is carried at its cost less any accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses.
- f) Assets over which the company has control, though created on land not belonging to the company are included under Property, Plant and Equipment's (PPE).
- g) Fixed Assets booked under the head of "Fixed Assets not in use" are transferred to "Stock"/ "Other Stock Account Head" at depreciated value and the accumulated depreciation thereon is reversed by debiting "Provision for Depreciation on Fixed Assets". The damaged Fixed Assets under the category "Transformers" after repair are accounted for at stock issue rate applicable as on date of reissue. "
