Inviting Comments on Petition for the post-facto approval of the Fuel Charge Adjustment (FCA) to be charged from the consumers for the period from 01.07.2014 to 30.09.2014 filed by UPCL before the Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission

Salient Points of the Petition

- 1. Uttarakhand Power Corporation Limited (UPCL), the sole Distribution and Retail Supply Licensee in the State, has filed a Petition before Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (UERC or Commission) for the post-facto approval of the Fuel Charge Adjustment (FCA) to be charged from the consumers during the period from 01.07.2014 to 30.09.2014.
- 2. UPCL has submitted the details of actual variable fuel cost for the period from April, 2014 to June, 2014 vis-a-vis variable charges approved by the Commission vide Tariff Order dated 10.04.2014 for FY 2014-15 which are given in the following Table:

- 3. UPCL also referring to the Tariff Order dated 10.04.2014 wherein, a surplus of Rs. 20.92 Crore was allowed to it with the direction to adjust the said surplus from the FCA, if any, becoming due for FY 2014-15, has submitted that, net value of FCA to be charged from the consumers for the period from July, 2014 to September, 2014 has been worked out as 38.21 20.92 = Rs.17.29 Crore.
- 4. To arrive at average FCA per unit, UPCL has considered sales of 2953.17 MUs for the second quarter based on the ratio of quarterly power purchase approved by Commission and net amount to be recovered as Rs. 17.29 Crore. UPCL has in its Petition proposed to charge average FCA of Rs. 0.06/kWh.
- 5. For the purpose of recovery of above referred FCA, UPCL has decided to impose additional charges over & above the existing tariff as follows:
