Note:-No equivalent degree for any other branches shall be consider an eligible qualification other than those specified here in the table above and no queries seeking clarification in the regard shall be entertained by the Commission.

General Conditions

1. The mode of appointment of this post is deputation from Central/State/UT Government Departments, Statutory/Autonomous/Constitutional/Cooperative/Local Government bodies and Public Sector Undertakings, Corporations etc. under administrative control of Central/State/UT Governments.
2. The Pay & Allowances and other terms and conditions of appointment on a deputation basis will be regulated in accordance with the rules of the State Government.
3. The Maximum age limit is 56 years on the last date of receipt of the applications.
4. The deputation shall be for a period upto 03 years initially, which may be extended as per deputation rules.
5. The crucial date for determination of eligibility criteria/age limit would be on 01.07.2025.

6. Further, only those applicants who hold the post as well as the pay scale of that post on substantive basis shall be considered eligible for appointment.
7. **The applications in the given format at Annexure-A is to be submitted to Secretary, Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission, 'Vidyut Niyamak Bhawan', Near ISBT, PO-Majra, Dehradun-248171 (Uttarakhand), along-with self-attested copies of certificates/mark sheets for educational qualifications (starting from matriculation), category and experience through Speed Post only so as to reach him latest by 24th December, 2025.**
8. Applicants in Central/State/UT Government service or in the service of Autonomous/Statutory Body/PSUs/ Corporations etc. should apply through proper channel only. The applications of such applicants should be forwarded with attested copies of Annual Confidential Reports of the last five years and vigilance clearance certificate. However, an advance copy may be sent directly by the candidate to avoid delay, and candidate shall produce the "No Objection Certificate" prior to interview, if called for.
9. Incomplete application or application submitted in a different format is liable to be summarily rejected.
10. The Commission reserves the right to cancel the applications found not to be complete in all respects.
11. Mere fulfilling the eligibility criteria does not entitle the candidate to be considered for selection process.
12. The Commission reserves the right to shortlist the applications and only shortlisted candidates shall called for interview.
13. The Commission reserves the right not to fill the above-mentioned vacancy.
