
Sir,

**ORDER**

This order relates to the SLDC Petition for True-up of FY 2024-25, Annual Performance Review for FY 2025-26 and Aggregate Revenue Requirement for FY 2026-27 filed by State Load Despatch Centre (hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner" or "SLDC") on 27.11.2025.

2. The Petition filed by SLDC had certain infirmities/deficiencies which were conveyed to SLDC via the Commission's letter dated 10.12.2025 asking it to rectify the same so that the Petition could be admitted. SLDC vide its letter dated 15.12.2025 has removed

the critical deficiencies.

3. Based on the Tariff Petition filed by SLDC, the Commission decides to admit the Petition provisionally for further processing subject to the condition that SLDC shall furnish any further information/clarifications as deemed necessary by the Commission during the processing of the Petition and provides such information and clarifications to the satisfaction of the Commission within the time frame as may be stipulated by the Commission failing which the Commission may proceed to dispose off the matter as it deems fit based on the information available with it.
4. The Commission further directs the Petitioner to publish a public notice in both in Hindi and English languages within 3 working days from the date of this Order detailing the salient features and facts of the Tariff Petition & proposal filed by it as per the format given at **Annexure-1** in at least two daily newspapers (one Hindi and one English) widely circulated in the area of its operation for comments by all stakeholders and public at large. The Petitioner is also directed to place the Petition on its website and its headquarters/other offices for inspection and for making relevant extracts available to the public.

**Salient features of Tariff Petition**

State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC), which has been made operational for grid control and dispatch of electricity and other related works w.e.f. November 27, 2012 in the State of Uttarakhand, has filed a petition before the Commission for True-up of FY 2024-25, Annual Performance Review for FY 2025-26 and Aggregate Revenue Requirement for FY 2026-27. The summary of proposal made by SLDC for the aforesaid is given in the following Table:

2. SLDC has proposed a total increase of 47.93% for FY 2026-27 over the approved SLDC charges for FY 2025-26. In case, the entire claim of SLDC is accepted by the



Commission, additional hike of 0.01% in consumer tariff shall be required over and above the hike proposed by UPCL. The recovery of the charges from the beneficiaries has been proposed through suitable fees and charges.
