ORDER

Heard the Petitioner and Respondent in the matter on admissibility of the Petition.

During the course of hearing, the Commission observed that the Petitioner has not furnished certain essential information in the Petition and has even not filed a written reply against the submission of the Respondent, but only made oral submissions during the course of hearing.

However, considering the facts of the matter and issues involved, the Commission deems it fit to admit the Petition. The Petition be admitted.

The Respondent is directed to file its reply on merits within 10 days from the date of this Order with an advance copy of the same to the Petitioner and Petitioner may file the rejoinder within 10 days thereafter.

The Petitioner and Respondent are directed to furnish the following information within 07 days of this Order :-

The Petitioner shall:-

- (1) Submit statutory procedure of synchronizing 6 MW waste to energy plant including clearance certification from Electrical Inspector, distribution licensee etc.
- (2) Furnish metering & protection SLD for the plant depicting generator, transformers, loads, auxiliary load, circuit breaker and protections etc.
- (3) Confirm whether its 6 MW waste to energy power plant is working in islanding mode or it is synchronized with the grid. Moreover, furnish details of protection mechanisms deployed for back feeding of power to the Grid, if plant is synchronized with the grid.
- (4) Furnish data sheet of its waste to energy power plant with salient features/writeup on how the Petitioner envisages to meet load requirements in absence of generation from its waste to energy power plant.

The Respondent shall:-

- (1) Furnish the details of correspondences made by it with the Petitioner since 08.09.2025 w.r.t. concerns raised by it in its reply dated 20.02.2026.
- (2) Submit record of maximum demand of the Petitioner for last 6 months.
