- 1.1 The present Petition was filed by the Petitioner under Section 86(1)(e) and (f) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 49 of the UERC (Tariff and other Terms for Supply of Electricity from Renewable Energy Sources and non-fossil fuel based co-generating stations) Regulations, 2018 as amended from time to time, seeking payment of deemed generation claims in respect of Motighat SHP and Tanga SHP.
- 1.2 The Commission vide its Daily Order dated 03.04.2024 had directed both the Petitioner and the Respondent to jointly sit together for monthly reconciliation of the deemed generation claimed by the Petitioner and settle the amount so arrived at within two months in accordance with the provisions of the RE Regulations. The Commission had further directed that the Petitioner would be at liberty to approach the Commission in case of non-resolution of its claims after expiry of the stipulated period.
- 1.3 The Commission observes that the Petitioner has not approached the Commission till date even after 2 years since the matter was last heard. Hence, the Commission is of the view that the matter cannot be left pending for so long & decides to dispose off the Petition.

Ordered accordingly.
