SUBJECT: REVISION OF NORMS FOR UP GRADATION OF GOVT. SCHOOLS.

The matter regarding revision of norms for up gradation of schools has been engaging the attention of the Govt. from past some time. Now it has been decided to revise the earlier norms for up gradation of schools issued vide Memo No. 14/41-2005 S.E (3) dated 30-01-2006. The revised norms for up gradation of schools henceforth will be as under:-

i. Student Strength

1	Primary to Middle	150 and at least 25 students studying in class 5th for the last two years.
2	Middle to High	150(6 th to 8 th) and at least 50 students studying in 8 th class for the last two years (Board of School Education data)
3	High to Sr. Secondary	150 In 9 th and 10 th classes as per record of the School Education Board.

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in addition to it, the newly upgraded schools should provide:-

- 1. The school building having more than one storey should provide one ramp and one staircase of at least 6' width.
- 2. Each section should not have more than 50 students.
- 3. The new school buildings should be Designed/Constructed keeping in view the safety measures of earth quake, fire and hygienic.
- 4. Before finally upgrading a school a letter of intent is to be issued to the Panchayat Municipal Committee/NAC where the school is located informing that the Government intends to upgrade the school. In case the school lacks certain norms these may be got completed after which the deployment of teachers and admission of the students will take place.
