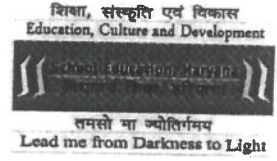

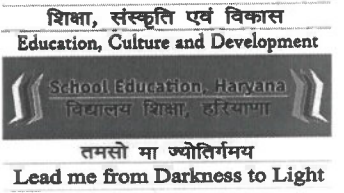

3 Smt. Santosh Tanwar is hereby further informed that if for the purpose of preparing her written statement, she wishes to have access to the relevant official records, she should inspect the same in the office of the Director Secondary Education Haryana, Panchkula, on any working day after making prior appointment with him. It is, however, pointed out that only such documents will be shown to her as are in the possession of the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana, Panchkula, and as are strictly relevant to the case. If in the opinion of the Government, it is not desirable in the public interest, to allow her access to any document, such access shall be refused. If, Smt. Santosh Tanwar wishes to consult any other relevant record, which is not in the custody of the Director Secondary Education Haryana Panchkula it is for her to undertake its inspection. It is, however, made clear to Smt. Santosh Tanwar that her failure to inspect the documents shall not constitute a valid ground for delay in the submission of her written statement and if the written statement is not received by the undersigned within the specified period, it shall be presumed that she has none to submit.

4 The written statement should be submitted direct to the undersigned.

Statement of allegations against Smt. Santosh Tanwar [049747] the then District Elementary Education Officer, Narnaul [6789] Mahendergarh [now Joint Director Office of Director, State Council of Educational Research and Training Gurugram]

While being posted as District Elementary Education Officer, Narnaul (Mahendergarh) from 02.02.2012 to 14.02.2012, 28.05.2013 to 31.05.2013 and 30.09.2013 to 27.11.2013 Smt. Santosh Tanwar committed certain acts of omission and commission for which she is charged as under:-

That Additional Director, Mid-Day-Meal Office of Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula was appointed as Inquiry Officer to enquire into the non-provision of Mid Day Meal to students of ASD High School, Narnaul from 01.02.2012 to 06.07.2014 and an enquiry was conducted on 22.07.2019, 24.07.2019 and 30.07.2019. The enquiry report dated 09.09.2019 was submitted by the Inquiry Officer and concluded that no demand of Rice was found to be made by ASD High School on or after last supply of Rice on 23.12.2013. Further, the District Authorities failed to inform about this fact to the Directorate i.e. Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula and thus, the District Education Officers, Narnaul and Block Education Officers, Narnaul posted during the said period, were found to be negligent. As such, following lapses were found to be committed on her part i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar:-



1. That she i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar failed to examine the work/record of demand and supply of Mid-day-Meal at District level while she was working as District Elementary Education Officer, Narnaul.
2. That an amount of Rs. 94974/- for Primary and Rs. 94886/- for Upper Primary respectively, was found to be released by the office of the District Elementary Education Officers, Narnaul to the Management of ASD High School, Narnaul and the school authorities/management i.e. ASD High School, Narnaul had withdrawn the amounts of Rs. 70947/- (Primary) and 67642/- (Upper Primary) respectively between the period 31.01.2012 to 21.10.2013 without providing Mid-Day-Meal facility to the students. As such, she i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar neither examined the record of the school management i.e. ASD High School, Narnaul under Mid-Day-Meal scheme nor any efforts was made by her i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar to enquire the matter. Thus, she i.e. Sh. Santosh Tanwar caused a loss of Rs. 1,38,589/- to the State Exchequer.
3. That the school management i.e. ASD High School, Narnaul had never maintained stock register, cashbook and other relevant documents regarding maintaining of Mid-Day-Meal in the school. She i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar neither made any surprise inspection of ASD High School, Narnaul, nor examined the authenticity of the honorarium being paid to the Mid-Day-Meal helpers of ASD High School, Narnaul. As such, she i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar failed to take prompt action in the matter and also never brought these facts to the notice of Higher Authorities/Directorate.
4. That she i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar failed to make arrangement for preparation, distribution and demand of Mid-Day-Meal for ASD High School, Narnaul and thus, she

gave promotion to mismanagement. Resultantly, deserving beneficiaries students were remained deprived from benefits of Mid-Day-Meal scheme and as such, complaint was made before the National Human Right Commission, New Delhi.

5. That she i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar failed to take prompt action at the relevant time in the matter and also failed to bring those facts into the notice of higher authorities/Directorate, as such due to her negligency i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar, penalty of Rs. 2 Lacs per eligible student was imposed by the National Human Right Commission, New Delhi.

In this way, she i.e. Smt. Santosh Tanwar remained negligent and irresponsible towards her Government duty and acted with malafide intention and as such, committed an act unbecoming of a Government officer and violated the provisions of rule 4(1) and (2) of the Haryana Civil Services, (Government Employees Conduct) Rules, 2016. Thus, she caused a total loss of Rs. 1,38,589/- to the State Exchequer.

The lapses detailed above constitute grave misconduct on the part of Smt. Santosh Tanwar [049747] the then District Elementary Education Officer, Narnaul [6789], Mahendergarh [now posted Joint Director Office of Director, State Council of Educational Research and Training, Gurugram], rendering her liable for strict disciplinary action under rule 7 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 2016.





Sunil Dutt remained negligent and irresponsible towards his Government duty and acted with malafide intention and as such, committed an act unbecoming of a Government officer and violated the provisions of rule 4(1) and (2) of the Haryana Civil Services, (Government Employees Conduct) Rules, 2016. Thus, he caused a total loss of Rs. 1,38,589/- to the State Exchequer.

The lapses detailed above constitute grave misconduct on the part of Sh. Sunil Dutt [051101] the then Block Education Officer, Narnaul, Mahendergarh [now posted as District Education Officer, Narnaul, Mahendergarh], rendering him liable for strict disciplinary action under rule 7 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 2016.

Statement of charges against Sh. Sunil Dutt [051101] the then Block Education Officer, Narnaul, Mahendergarh [now District Education Officer, Narnaul, Mahendergarh]

While being posted as Block Education Officer, Narnaul (Mahendergarh) from 28.03.2012 to 10.09.2018, Sh. Sunil Dutt committed following acts of omission and commission for which he is charged as under:-



That Additional Director, Mid-Day-Meal Office of Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula, was appointed an Inquiry Officer to enquire into the non-provision of Mid Day Meal to students of ASD High School, Narnaul from 01.02.2012 to 06.07.2014 and an enquiry was conducted on 22.07.2019, 24.07.2019 and 30.07.2019. The enquiry report dated 09.09.2019 was submitted by the Inquiry Officer and concluded that no demand of Rice was made by ASD High School on or after last supply of Rice on 23.12.2013. Further, the District Authorities failed to inform about this fact to the Directorate i.e. Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula and thus, the District Education Officers, Narnaul and Block Education Officers, Narnaul posted during the said period, were found to be negligent. As such, following lapses were found to be committed on his part i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt:-

1. That no demand of Rice was found to be made by Management of ASD High School Narnaul on or after 23.12.2013. Thus, he i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt failed to examine the work/record of demand and supply of Mid-day-Meal at Block level while he was working as Block Education Officer and also failed to brought the aforesaid facts in the notice of the Higher Authorities and the Directorate.
2. That an amount of Rs. 94974/- for Primary and Rs. 94886/- for Upper Primary respectively, was found to be released by the office of the District Elementary Education Officers, Narnaul to the Management of ASD High School, Narnaul and the school authorities/management i.e. ASD High School, Narnaul had withdrawn the amounts of Rs. 70947/- (Primary) and 67642/- (Upper Primary) respectively between the period 31.01.2012 to 21.10.2013 without providing Mid-Day-Meal facility to the students. As such, he i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt neither examined the record of the school management i.e. ASD High School, Narnaul under Mid-Day-Meal scheme nor any efforts was made by him i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt to enquire the matter. Thus, he i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt cause a loss of Rs. 1,38,589/- to the State Exchequer.
3. That the school management i.e. ASD High School, Narnaul had never maintained stock register, cashbook and other relevant documents regarding maintaining of Mid-Day-Meal in the school. He i.e. Sunil Dutt neither made any surprise inspection of ASD High School, Narnaul, nor examined the authenticity of the honorarium being paid to the Mid-Day-Meal helpers of ASD High School, Narnaul and also failed to take prompt action in the matter and never brought this fact to the notice of Higher Authorities.

4. That he i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt failed to make arrangement for preparation, distribution and demand of Mid-Day-Meal for ASD High School, Narnaul and thus, gave promotion to mismanagement. Resultantly, deserving beneficiaries students were remained deprived from benefits of the Mid-Day-Meal scheme and as such, complaint was made before the National Human Right Commission, New Delhi.
5. That he i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt failed to take prompt action at the relevant time in the matter and also failed to bring those facts into the notice of higher authorities, as such due to his negligency i.e. Sh. Sunil Dutt, penalty of Rs. 2 Lacs per eligible student was imposed by the National Human Right Commission, New Delhi.

In this way, he i.e. Sh.
