With reference to your application and subsequent correspondence with the school/inspection in this regard, I convey the grant for provisional recognition to **Made Easy School, Vill. Bandhwari, Gurugram** class 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> with effect from 01.04.2019 run by Managing Committee **Surajmal Educational Foundation, H.No. 250, Sector-5, Distt. Gurugram.**

The above sanction is subject to fulfilment of following conditions:-

1. The grant for recognition is Class not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond Class VIII.
2. The school shall by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Haryana State Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011.
3. The school shall admit in class I, to the extent of the Strength of that class. Children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion:



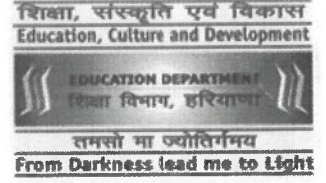



Dated Panchkula the, 01.01.2020

Whereas Mahesh Kumar approached the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court by way of filing a Civil Writ Petition i.e. CWP No.9187/2017- Mahesh Kumar V/s State of Haryana & others praying therein for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide 3% reservation to handicapped teachers in promotion from SS Master to Elementary School Head Masters. It is further prayed that during the pendency of the present writ petition petitioner may kindly be promoted or in alternate I seat may kindly be kept reserved for the petitioner.

The said petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 15.05.2017 and was disposed off with the following directions:-

*"By this petition the petitioner has prayed for issuance of directions to respondents to provide 3% reservation to handicapped teachers in promotion from S.S.Master to Elementary School Head Master. On the last date the following order was passed:*

*"Counsel for the petitioner states that she has been informed that the government has allowed reservation to be made for persons with disabilities in promotion posts also.*

*Learned AAG Haryana seeks a short adjournment to verify this fact.*

*Adjourned to 15.5.2017."*

*Today Assistant Advocate General has placed on record copy of notification dated 17/19 April 2017, the same is taken on record and marked as Mark 'A'. As per this notification, the Government has decided to reserve 3% posts for promotion to sGroup A, B, C and D with effect from the date person with disability Act came into force, those posts which have been identified the persons with disabilities as per notification of the Government of India dated 29.7.2013. Copy of this notification is taken on record and has been marked as Mark 'A'.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of this notification the present petition has become infructuous and the only prayer which is left is that State should consider the claim of the petitioner within any reasonable time.*

*I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, present petition stands disposed of as having become infructuous with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the claim of the petitioner in view of the notification Mark 'A' within a period of 6 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the petitioner is found to entitled any relief the same be granted to him within aforesaid period.*

*Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of."*


In compliance of this order, the matter has been perused in detail. After due consideration, it has been found that some identical handicapped teachers have also filed a writ petition claiming the promotion to the post of Elementary School Head Master. In pursuance of judgment dated 15.05.2017, the case of the petitioner has been examined and it has been found that the petitioner is 70% physically handicapped and was initially appointed on the basis of handicapped against the post reserved for handicapped. The petitioner has claimed promotion in reservation on seat reserved for handicapped employee to provide 3% reservation in case of promotion to post of Elementary School Headmaster under the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules-2012.

In the view of above, a UO letter No. 17/29-2014 HRM-III (2) dated 20.09.2019 had sent to HRM-I branch for fixation of seniority in physical handicapped category and a copy of seniority list to this branch for further necessary action i.e. compliance of the direction issued by the Hon'ble High Court on 15.05.2017.

In the view of above, it is pertinent to mention here that the seniority of physical handicapped of Master category is under active consideration with the answering respondent. The provisional seniority list has been prepared on 12.12.2019 and the same was uploaded on the website of the Department on 17.12.2019. The objections were called from all the District Education Officer of the State, District Elementary Education Officer of the State, Director SCERT, Haryana, Gurugram, Director School Education, U.T., Chandigarh. It has been clearly mentioned in the letter dated 17.12.2019 that if any suggestions/ objection raised by any master regarding the seniority of the physical handicapped then the documents i.e. appointment letter/promotion order and handicapped certificate etc. of the official be sent through e-mail [hrm1branch@gmail.com](mailto:hrm1branch@gmail.com) in HRM-I branch up to 23.12.2019. It has been clearly mentioned in the letter dated 17.12.2019 that if any objection/suggestions received after the finalization of provisional seniority list of physical handicapped then the same shall not be considered and you will be personally responsible. Now, some suggestions/objections have been received in the Department and the same are being considered. After considering all the objections, the seniority of physical handicapped of Master cadre shall be finalized. This process will take some time to finalize the seniority of physical handicapped as stood on 12.12.2019. The cases of the petitioners for promotion to the post of ESHM under physical handicapped category shall be considered on the basis of their seniority number as stood in the seniority list dated 12.12.2019.

Now considering the matter from all corners, I found that the grievances of the petitioners deserve to be satisfied but their cases can only be examined for promotion when the final seniority of handicapped (Master cadre) shall be finalized by HRM-I branch. The final outcome/report of seniority list of handicapped is still awaited.

Whereas Shri Bhagwan and another approached the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court by way of filing a Civil Writ Petition i.e. CWP No.30862/2019- Shri Bhagwan and another V/s State of Haryana & another praying therein for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioners (Physically Handicapped Employee) as Middle Head with all consequential benefits in accordance with the reservation policy for handicapped employee dated 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 (annexure P-7) as per which 3% posts in a cadre have been reserved for persons with disabilities and also in the light of judgment dated 18.03.2010 (Annexure P-6) passed by this Hon'ble Court.

The said petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 24.10.2019 and was disposed off with the following directions:-

***"Prayer in the writ petition is for issuance of mandamus directing the respondents to promote petitioners, being physically handicapped employees, as Middle Head with all consequential benefits in accordance with reservation policy for Handicapped Employees (Annexure P-7) in the light of judgment dated 18.03.2010 (Annexure P-6).***

***Learned counsel for petitioners submits that petitioners will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector 5, Panchkula to consider the legal notice dated 08.02.2019 (Annexure P-10) in terms of judgment (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.***

***Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioners, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector 5, Panchkula to consider the legal notice dated 08.02.2019 (Annexure P-10) in terms of judgment (Annexure P-6) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and pass a speaking order thereon failing which respondent No.2 shall be liable to pay costs of `25,000/- to the petitioners. This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioners from running pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.***

***The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction."***
