Subject:- Weightage of Marks for debilitating diseases under Para-7(iii) (b) (5) and protected employees under Para-9(i) – date of issuance of certificates – clarification thereof.

The revised teachers transfer policy has been issued on 5.06.2017 and subsequent transfers of teaching category would be done as per revised transfer policy. As per Para-5(ii) (c) the qualifying date for actual vacancies, deemed vacancies, weightage/merit points calculations, count of stay shall be 31st March of the calendar year of transfers. As per Para-7(iii) (b) (5) certificates issued during last one year will be valid for availing the weightage under this Para. Similarly certificate for cancel should not be sixth month old as per provisions of Para-9(i) of the policy.

Since both the provisions are added afresh in the new transfer policy, date of issuance of certificates is currently being filled up by the employees. Employees, whose certificates had lost the validity, are getting fresh certificates issued on the current date, which is later than the date of eligibility fixed under Para- 5(ii) (c) of the policy. Date of issuance, if the same is a date after 31st March 2017 may create a confusion to the system at the time of calculation of the date of issuance of certificate. Therefore, for this year, certificates issued between 1st April 2017 and date of initiating the transfer drive would also be considered as valid for the purpose of giving weightage under Para-7(iii) (b) (5) and Para-9(i) of the policy. In this way the validation period of the certificate equivalent to no. of days between 31st March 2017 and date of initiation of drive for the respective cadre would deemed extended.
