Whereas, Petitioner has filed the CWP No. 12533 of 2020 titled as Virender Singh Vs. State of Haryana & Another before the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the transfer order 14.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) vide which the department has transferred the petitioner, who is an 50% physical handicapped, to District Education Office, Panchkula, Barwala. The petitioner further prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to incorporate the Govt. instructions/letter/ policy/office memorandum dated 10.05.1990 (P-7), 13.03.2002(P-8), 06.10.2004(P-10), 23.12.2008(P-11) and office memorandum 31.03.2014(P-9) in the implementation of the Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff-2020, dated 06.03.2020, with additional prayer to transfer the petitioner at his previous place of posting.

The above said Civil Writ Petition came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on 05.02.2021 and the same was disposed of with following orders:-

"This court further notices the fact that the last online transfer policy was issued on 06.03.2020. it is likely that the fresh policy would be issued by the department for the coming year. In the peculiar facts and circumstances as noticed above the present writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:-

1. The petitioner is liberty to file a fresh representation within 10 days from today and may also attach all

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- relevant documents including the petitioner's transfer preference report earlier submitted on 09.08.2020.
- 2. The authority concern may examine the representation of the petitioner and in case there is some vacant post in one of the schools where the petitioner had given preference, considering the petitioner's disability as 50% his case be sympathetically considered as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the representation.
- 3. The petitioner is also at liberty to apply for his transfer preference report in case fresh policy is issued by the department in the meantime.

Disposed of."

In compliance of the abovementioned orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the representation of the petitioner dated 24.02.2021 was examined & on examination of the record of the petitioner, it was found that the petitioner was transferred in 'Anywhere in the State Category' due to low merit points and non availability of preferred stations.

Whereas, the Government of Haryana framed Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020. Thereupon, transfers were made under this policy to ensure equitable distribution of Ministerial Cadre Employees of the Department across the State, in a fair & transparent manner and to maximize job satisfaction amongst employees. Under this policy all government schools/ institutes have been categorized into seven zones for the purpose of transfer of clerks and every participant is eligible to opt for any number of schools/ institutes across the zones available to him/her. He/She is free to give preferences in order of his/her suitability, so that chances of being posted in 'Anywhere in the State' category may be reduced.



Further it is stated that according to the Para No. 4 sub clause V (b), the department is at liberty to post an employee anywhere in the State if he/she fails to get one of his/her preferred options. Thus the petitioners got the stations as per the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020.

Whereas the stations were blocked by following due process of rationalization. It is worthwhile to mention here that according to the sub clause-iv of Clause-4 of online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department can block actual vacant post for the purpose of rationalization. Sub clause-iv of Clause-4 online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020 is as under:-

iv) Rationalization and Blocking of posts: To avoid disproportionate concentration of employees at a particular station, the department should rationalize their sanctioned posts and also block actual vacant post to be kept vacant in the transfer drive. In the long run, however, the department may increase/decrease the sanctioned posts as per number of assessment/requirement in consultation with work Assessment Cell Reforms Department and Administrative in Department.

The posts with less workload were blocked by the department, because stations with overwork load require more employee for smooth working in the department. So, for maximum utilization of the potential of an employee at over work loaded station and to avoid misappropriate concentration of employees at a particular station, the blocking of posts was done by the process of rationalization in the public interest.

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Moreover, the stations were blocked by the department by following the proper criteria i.e. the schools in which the student strength is less than 125, were blocked for the purpose of proper utilization of the manpower available with the department. Thus, the process of rationalization was conducted for the purpose of even distribution of clerks in the State, as per mandate of Clause 4 (iv) of Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Whereas as per the provisions of the policy, allotment of a vacant seat/station to an employee is based on total composite score earned by the employee concerned out of total 80 score points. The employee concerned earning highest score is entitled to be transferred against a particular vacancy. For merit points, age is prime factor for deciding the claim of the employee against a vacancy, as it has weightage of maximum of 60 points out of total 80 points. However, it is worthwhile to mention here that the categories like women, widows, widowers, differently-abled persons, employees with serious ailments, a privilege of maximum 20 points can be availed by the employees. Therefore, the employees were asked to opt maximum stations as per their choice suitable to them so that their chances of getting posted on an un-opted station in 'anywhere in the state category' may be reduced. In other words, if a employee could not be transferred against any of the stations preferred by him/her, he/she shall be transferred under 'Anywhere in the State' category. In case an employee is to be transferred on an un-opted station in "Anywhere in state" category then Computer Programme/Software, instead of sending them at a distant place, searches for a vacancy nearest to them and put them at that vacancy as per their merit points.

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Whereas, according to general principles of the policy, every employee is responsible for the accuracy and regular updation of data in MIS in respect of his/her credentials, otherwise the department is at liberty to transfer him anywhere category in the state. Employees are liable to be transferred under this policy in any zone or anywhere in the State, in public interest, on completion of prescribed tenure.

Whereas, the petitioner opted for 108 stations in his preferences according to his suitability/choices and obtained the score of 42.1205 points as per transfer policy. But due to low merit score he could not get the station out of his 108 preferences. It is worthwhile to mention here that all the 108 preferences of the petitioner were allocated to the employees having high merit points. The last i.e. 108th station was allocated to another employee namely Rajesh Kumar with score of 46.0027 points which is clearly higher than that of the petitioner. Therefore, petitioner was transferred in 'Anywhere in the State' category. Moreover, no post is vacant out of 108 preferred stations opted by the petitioner. Thus the petitioner has got the station i.e. District Education office, Barwala, Panchkula as per the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 6.3.2020.

In such circumstances, petitioner has been transferred by the Department in strict compliance to the transfer policy dated 06.03.2020. Therefore, the claim of the petitioner is hereby rejected, being devoid of merits.

Whereas, the Petitioners have filed the CWP No. 15166 of 2020 titled as Krishan Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana & another before the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 14.08.2020 (P-3) qualithe petitioners only vide which the petitioners have been transferred at far away places. Further, petitioners prayed that the respondents be directed to stay the operation of the transfer.

The above said Civil Writ Petition came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on 28.01.2021 and the same was disposed of with following orders:

"Prayer seems to be justified.

Learned State Counsel has raised no objection in case the innocuous prayer of the petitioners is accepted.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioners to make a representation to respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks from today and the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within two weeks thereafter in case there is no legal impediment.

It is clarified that in case the desired representation is not decided within the stipulated time, the same shall be considered as disobedience of the order of this Court.

It is also clarified that interim order dated 23.09.2020 will continue till the representation is decided in accordance with law.

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Since main writ petition stands disposed off, therefore, the pending applications, if any, shall also dispose off."

Moreover, most of the clerical work with regard to the elementary schools has been done from the office of Block Elementary Education office. As such there is no clerical workload in elementary schools and most of the posts in the elementary schools were blocked by the department due to less workload and the same was done in a fair manner & no teacher was allotted the clerical work till date.

It is also clarified that interim order dated 08.09.2020 will continue till the representation is decided in accordance with law.

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Since main writ petition stands disposed off, therefore, the pending applications, if any, shall also dispose off."

In compliance of the abovementioned orders of the Hon'ble High Court the department examined the representation dated 06.02.2021 of the petitioners & it was found that all the petitioners were transferred in accordance with the Policy. The petitioner no's 2, 4, 5 & 6 were compulsorily participants of the Transfer Policy 2020 as they completed the required teure of five years in their particular zone and petitioner no's 1, 3 & 7 were voluntarily participants of the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020. All the petitioners opted stations according to their suitability and choices. But due to low merit scores obtained by them they did not get station opted by them. Such stations were given/allocated to the employees who have scored higher points than the petitioners. Therefore, petitioners were transferred 'Anywhere in the State' category.

Whereas, the Government of Haryana framed Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020. Thereupon, transfers were made under this policy to ensure equitable distribution of Ministerial Cadre Employees of the Department across the State, in a fair & transparent manner and to maximize job satisfaction amongst employees. Under this policy all government schools/ institutes have been categorized into seven zones for the purpose of transfer of clerks and every participant is eligible to opt for any number of schools/ institutes across the zones available to him/her. He/She is free to give preferences in order of his/her suitability. So that chances of being posted in 'Anywhere in the State' category may be decreased. Further it is stated that according to the Para No. 4 sub clause V (b), the department is at liberty to post an employee anywhere in the State if he/she fails to get one of



his/her preferred options. Thus the petitioners got the stations as per the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020.

Whereas the stations were blocked by following the process of rationalization. It is worthwhile to mention here that according to the sub clause-iv of Clause-4 of online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department can block actual vacant post for the purpose of rationalization. Sub clause-iv of Clause-4 online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020 is as under:-

iv) Rationalization and Blocking of posts: To avoid disproportionate concentration of employees at a particular station, the department should rationalize their sanctioned posts and also block actual vacant post to be kept vacant in the transfer drive. In the long run, however, the department may increase/decrease the total number of sanctioned posts as per the assessment/requirement in consultation with work Assessment Cell in the Administrative Reforms Department and Finance Department.

The posts with less workload were blocked by the department, because stations with overwork load require more employee for smooth working in the department. So, for maximum utilization of the potential of an employee at over work loaded station and to avoid misappropriate concentration of employees at a particular station, the blocking of posts was done by the process of rationalization in the public interest.

Moreover, the stations were blocked by the department by following the proper criteria i.e. the schools, in which the student strength is less than 125, were blocked for the purpose of proper utilization of the manpower available with the department, due to the process of rationalization. Thus for the purpose of even distribution of clerks in the State,

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the process of rationalization was done as per mandate of Clause 4 (iv) of Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Whereas as per the provisions of the policy, allotment of a vacant seat/stations to an employee is based on total composite score earned by the employee concerned out of total 80 score points. The employee concerned earning highest score is entitled to be transferred against a particular vacancy. For merit points, age is prime factor for deciding the claim of the employee against a vacancy, as it has weightage of maximum of 60 points out of total 80 points. However, it is worthwhile to mention here that the categories like women, widows, widowers, differently-abled persons, employees with serious ailments, a privilege of maximum 20 points can be availed by the employees. Therefore, the employees were asked to opt maximum stations as per their choice suitable to them so that their chances of getting posted on an un-opted station in 'anywhere in the state category' may be reduced. In other words, if a employee could not be transferred against any of the stations preferred by him/her, he/she shall be transferred under 'Anywhere in the State' category. In case an employee is to be transferred on an un-opted station in "Anywhere in state" category then Computer Programme/Software, instead of sending them at a distant place, searches for a vacancy nearest to them and put them at that vacancy as per their merit points.

Whereas, according to general principles of the policy, every employee is responsible for the accuracy and regular updation of data in MIS in respect of his/her credentials, otherwise the department is at liberty to transfer him in Anywhere category in the state. Employees are liable to be transferred under this policy in any zone or anywhere in the State, in public interest, on completion of prescribed tenure.

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Whereas, the contention with regard to the Right of education is concerned the Government of Haryana framed the Haryana Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 dated 03.06.2011 for the teachers and the same are not applicable to the clerks. Thus the clerks do not fall under the ambit of Haryana Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011. Moreover, most of the clerical work with regard to the elementary schools has been done from the office of Block Elementary Education office. As such there is no clerical workload in elementary schools and most of the posts in the elementary schools were blocked by the department due to less workload and the same was done in a fair manner.
