It is for the information of those PGTs who have applied for their posting in Government Model Sanskriti Senior Secondary Schools that **Online 90 minutes MCQ Assessment Test has been scheduled for 23.12.2021 from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Login details for the same have also been sent to all applicants through email.

If any candidate has not received the details yet, let us know immediately at **academiccellhry@gmail.com**. In this regard, claim of the candidates after 22.12.2021 at 2:00 p.m. will not be considered by the Department.

**Instructions for the candidates to be adhered to during the Assessment Test to be held on 23.12.2021 from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. are as under:-**

1. Candidates need to carry any of the ID proof viz. Aadhar Card, Employee ID Card etc. The name and photograph of the candidate will be verified with the Aadhaar or Employee ID Card. If the Name and Photo on the hall ticket match the Aadhaar/Employee ID Card, only then the candidate will be allowed for the test. Candidates will **not** be allowed to take the test without valid Id proof.
2. Bring a copy of the Hall Ticket.
3. The candidates must sign the Hall Ticket in the presence of the invigilator and give it back to the invigilator before leaving the test center.
4. Candidates need to carry a pen or pencil for rough work. Candidates are not allowed to carry rough sheets. Rough sheets will be provided in the center. Any calculations/rough work should be done on the rough papers provided to the candidates. All rough sheets used during the test should also be handed over to the center In-charge or invigilator, before leaving the test center.
5. Candidates need to wear a mask while entering the test center and during the test. COVID-19 guidelines issued from time to time by the Government must be adhered to.
6. Candidates are expected to reach the center 30 minutes before the time slot (i.e. by 1:30 p.m.) so that they can enter the room on time after the checks. In case a candidate is late, he/she will be allowed to

- start the test up to 50 minutes after the start time (i.e. by 2:00 p.m.) and system will automatically stop further login at 2:50 p.m.
7. Candidates reaching late will **not** get any extra time for the test and test will be over at 3:30 p.m. for all candidates.
  8. In the rare event of a computer issue at the center, candidates will be given extra time accordingly.
  9. Mobiles or any other electronic devices are **not** allowed inside the test center.
  10. Candidates are advised not to carry the luggage in the center. The center will **not** be responsible for candidate belongings.
  11. Candidates may be allowed to carry their water bottles inside the center (though centers will also have drinking water facilities).
  12. In case any candidate is found speaking with other candidates, making noise, causing the disturbance in the center, trying to use chits or any other material, not wearing mask properly, or not following any other guidelines provided; the candidate will be sent out of the test center. This judgment to give a warning or ask a candidate to leave the center lies entirely with the center In-charge or Invigilator.
  13. Candidates are **not** allowed to copy any question from the computer.
  14. No person other than candidate will be allowed to enter inside the test center.
