Whereas the petitioner has filed CWP No. 13138 of 2020 titled as Bharat Bhushan Vs State of Haryana & another, before the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned transfer order dated 14.08.2020 (P-4) for transferring the petitioner from Govt. Girls Middle School Bhawar (4084), Block Kathura, District Sonapat to District Education Office Yamuna Nagar (4610), Block Jagadhari, Yamunanagar.

The above said Civil Writ Petition came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on dated 10.11.2021 and the same was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to approach to the department. Relevant portion of order dated 10.11.2021 is reproduced as follows :-

"At the time of hearing, Id. Counsel for the petitioner on instructions, wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to make representation to respondent no.2 for redressal of his grievance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

It is clarified that in case the representation is made to respondent no.2 within one week from the receipt of certified copy of this order, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law by speaking order within next two weeks."

In compliance of the abovementioned orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the representation of the petitioner was received in the department on dated 25.11.2021 and the same was minutely examined & it was found that the petitioner voluntarily participated in the online transfer drive 2020 and in case

of voluntarily participation there is no need to complete the minimum tenure of 5 years. The petitioner opted for 90 stations and obtained the merit score of 44.0986 points, as per transfer policy of Ministerial Staff and the 90th preferred station was allocated to one employee namely, Samunder Singh (047304) who obtained the score of 56.4411 points. The petitioner was transferred in **Anywhere in the State** category due to non-availability of preferred stations as the same were allotted to the persons higher in merit. The same has been done in a fair & transparent manner in strict compliance of the Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Whereas, the Government of Haryana framed Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020. Thereupon, transfers were made under this policy to ensure equitable distribution of Ministerial Cadre Employees of the Department across the State in a fair & transparent manner and to maximize job satisfaction amongst employees. Under this policy all government schools/ institutes have been categorized into seven zones for the purpose of transfer of clerks and every participant is eligible to opt for any number of schools/ institutes across the zones available to him/her. He/She is free to give preferences in order of his/her suitability. So that chances of being posted in '**Anywhere in the State**' category may be decreased. Further according to the Para No. 4 sub clause V (b) of the Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department is at liberty to post an employee anywhere in the State if he/she fails to get one of his/her preferred options. Thus the petitioners got the stations as per the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020.

Whereas the stations were blocked by following the process of rationalization. It is worthwhile to mention here that according to the sub clause-iv of Clause-4 of online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the

department can block actual vacant post for the purpose of rationalization. Sub clause-iv of Clause-4 online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020 is as under:-

iv) Rationalization and Blocking of posts: To avoid disproportionate concentration of employees at a particular station, the department should rationalize their sanctioned posts and also block actual vacant post to be kept vacant in the transfer drive. In the long run, however, the department may increase/decrease the total number of sanctioned posts as per the assessment/requirement in consultation with work Assessment Cell in the Administrative Reforms Department and Finance Department.

The posts with less workload were blocked by the department, because stations with over workload require more employees for smooth working in the department. So, for maximum utilization of the potential of an employee at over workloaded station and to avoid misappropriate concentration of employee at a particular station, the blocking of posts was done by the process of rationalization in the public interest.

Moreover, the stations were blocked by the department by following the proper criteria i.e. the schools in which the student strength is less than 125 were blocked for the purpose of proper utilization of the manpower available with the department and the same was a reduced later on to 55 students per school on the recruitment of new clerks for the purpose of temporary posting of these new recruited clerks. Thus for the process of even distribution of clerks in the State the process of rationalization was done as per mandate of Clause 4 (iv) of Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Whereas as per the provisions of the policy, allotment of a vacant seat/stations to an employee is based on total composite score earned by the employee concerned out of total 80 score points. The employee concerned earning highest score is entitled to be transferred against a particular vacancy. For merit points, age is prime factor for deciding the claim of the employee against a vacancy, as it has weightage of maximum of 60 points out of total 80 points. However, it is worthwhile to mention here that the categories like women, widows, widowers, differently-abled persons, employees with serious ailments, a privilege of maximum 20 points can be availed by the employees. Therefore, the employees were asked to opt for maximum stations as per their choice suitable to them so that their chances of getting posted on an un-opted station in 'anywhere in the state category' may be reduced. In other words, if a employee could not be transferred against any of the stations preferred by him/her, he/she shall be transferred under '**Anywhere in the State**' category. In case, an employee is to be transferred on an un-opted station in "Anywhere in state" category then Computer Programme/Software, instead of sending them at a distant place, searches for a vacancy nearest to them and put them at that vacancy as per their merit points.

Whereas, according to general principles of the policy, every employee is responsible for the accuracy and regular updation of data in MIS in respect of his/her credentials, otherwise the department is at liberty to transfer him anywhere category in the state. Employees are liable to be transferred under this policy in any zone or anywhere in the State, in public interest, on completion of prescribed tenure.

In view of the circumstances mentioned above, petitioner has been transferred by the Department in strict compliance to the transfer policy

dated 06.03.2020. Therefore, the claim of the petitioner is hereby rejected,
being devoid of merits.

I order accordingly.

ORDER No. 13/124-2020 HRME- I(4)

Whereas the petitioner has filed CWP No. 13297 of 2020 titled as Sujata Yadav Vs State of Haryana & Another, before the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order no. 22/66-2020 HRME-1 (4) dated 14.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) vide which the petitioner has been transferred from Govt. Sr. Sec. School Khori, (2529) Block Khol at Rewari District Rewari to Govt. High School, Marora (934) Block Nagina District Nuh-Mewat. Petitioner further prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents either to allocate the petitioner her home district or the alternative.

The above said Civil Writ Petition came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on 08.11.2021 and the same was adjourned by passing following orders:-

“Learned counsel for petitioner seeks time to make a representation to the competent authority within one week from today. In case such a representation is made within the stipulated period, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law within next two weeks.

Till the next date of hearing, interim order to continue.”

In compliance of the abovementioned orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the representation of the petitioner was examined & it was found that the petitioner was transferred in accordance with the Transfer Policy 2020, as the petitioner was voluntary participant of the Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff 2020. She opted for 89 stations and obtained merit score of

33.074 points, as per transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020. The 89th preferred station of the petitioner, was allocated to the employee namely, Pawan Singh, who scored (50.9671) points. The petitioner opted stations according to her suitability and choices. But due to low merit scores obtained by the petitioner, she could not get station opted by her and therefore transferred in '**Anywhere in the State**' category. Such preferred stations were give/allocated to the employees who have scored higher marks than the petitioner.

Whereas, the Government of Haryana framed Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020. Thereupon, transfers were made under this policy to ensure equitable distribution of Ministerial Cadre Employees of the Department across the State, in a fair & transparent manner and to maximize job satisfaction amongst employees. Under this policy all the government schools/ institutes have been categorized into seven zones for the purpose of transfer of clerks and every participant is eligible to opt for any number of schools/ institutes across the zones available to him/her. He/She is free to give preferences in order of his/her suitability, so that chances of being posted in '**Anywhere in the State**' category may be decreased. Further, according to the Para No. 4 sub clause V (b) of the Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department is at liberty to post an employee anywhere in the State if he/she fails to get one of his/her preferred options. Thus the petitioner got the stations as per the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020.

Whereas the stations were blocked by following the process of rationalization. It is worthwhile to mention here that according to the sub clause-iv of Clause-4 of online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department can block actual vacant post for the purpose of rationalization.

Sub clause-iv of Clause-4 online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020 is as under:-

iv) Rationalization and Blocking of posts: To avoid disproportionate concentration of employees at a particular station, the department should rationalize their sanctioned posts and also block actual vacant post to be kept vacant in the transfer drive. In the long run, however, the department may increase/decrease the total number of sanctioned posts as per the assessment/requirement in consultation with work Assessment Cell in the Administrative Reforms Department and Finance Department.

The posts with less workload were blocked by the department, because stations with over workload require more employees for smooth working in the department. So, for maximum utilization of the potential of an employee at over workloaded station and to avoid misappropriate concentration of employees at a particular station, the blocking of posts was done by the process of rationalization in the public interest.

Moreover, the posts with less workload were blocked by the department, because stations with over work-load require more employees for smooth working in the department. So for maximum utilization of the potential of an employee at over work loaded stations and to avoid misappropriate concentration of employees at a particular station, blocking of posts was done by the process of rationalization in the public interest. Further it is stated here that the department has blocked the Middle Schools, where the posts of clerks were lying vacant due to less strength of the students i.e. minimum 125 students, but where the strength of the students is more than 125, the transfer of clerks has been done as per the online transfer policy. Thus for the process of even distribution of clerks in the State the process of

rationalization was done as per mandate of Clause 4 (iv) of Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Whereas it is germane to mention here that these seats were opened only for the purpose of temporary posting of the clerks who later on joined the department after the present transfer drive by following the proper criteria and lowered the strength of students from 125 to 55 only for the purpose of temporary posting. It is pertinent to mention here that these new appointees will also have to compete with the other clerks in the next transfer drive whenever the same will be conducted by the department.

Whereas as per the provisions of the policy, allotment of a vacant seat/station to an employee is based on total composite score earned by the employee concerned out of total 80 score points. The employee concerned earning highest score is entitled to be transferred against a particular vacancy. For merit points, age is prime factor for deciding the claim of the employee against a vacancy, as it has weightage of maximum of 60 points out of total 80 points. However, it is worthwhile to mention here that the categories like women, widows, widowers, differently-abled persons, employees with serious ailments, a privilege of maximum 20 points can be availed by the employees. Therefore, the employees were asked to opt for maximum stations as per their choice suitable to them so that their chances of getting posted on an un-opted station in 'anywhere in the state category' may be reduced. 




