ORDER NO. 6/21-2021 HRG-I(1)

DATED PANCHKULA, THE 08-9-2022

Whereas, Sh. Om Parkash [051061] and Shri Rameshwar [051057], Principals have filed the present writ petition No. 2755 of 2021 with the prayer to grant of promotion w.e.f. from the date their juniors were promoted as Principals and to consider them for promotion as Block Education Officer by placing them above in the seniority of principals.

That the present case came up for the hearing before this Hon'ble Court on 09.02.2021 and passed the following order:

"The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner No.1 and 2 claim to have been appointed as lecturers on 24.10.1991 and 29.10.1991, respectively. In 2012, they were promoted as school Principals. It is claimed that juniors to the writ petitioners were also promoted. On 08.07.2019, the seniority list of lecturers was issued and the petitioners were depicted seniors to their juniors who were also promoted. Even in the seniority list issued for the cadre of Principals, the petitioners were placed seniors to the said juniors. The petitioners through the present writ petition pray that they are entitled to be considered for promotion to the post of Principal with effect from the date their juniors were promoted to the post of Principal. It has also been brought to the notice of the Court that various writ petitions have been filed in this Court for identical relief. Once such writ petition is disposed of, the officials grant them the benefit of antedated promotion. He contends that the petitioners are identically situated.

Notice of motion.

On the request of this Court, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice and prays for time to file reply.

Respondent No.2 is directed to file an affidavit as to why all the identically situated employees are being compelled to file writ petitions. List on 13.05.2021."

In compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court relevant record of the matter was examined and found that Shri Kundan Kalra [002823] was placed at seniority no. 1099 of PGTs as stood on 01.04.2005 and promoted as Principal vide order no 4/30-2007 HRG-I(2) dated 20.07.2007. As a result of which, the officers senior to Shri Kundan Kalra [002823] filed various writ petitions for antedated promotion w.e.f. 20.07.2007 at par with Shri Kundan Kalra [002823] promoted as principal on 20.07.2007. To find out ambiguity, a committee was constituted vide order no. 15/64-2020 PGT-I(3) dated 29.12.2020/31.12.2020 to examine and fix the seniority of Shri Kundan Kalra, Principal (Retd) which consists of the following members:-

1. Smt. Sunita Rani, Joint Director
2. Sh. Ramesh Duhan, CAO
3. Smt. Vandhan Gupta, Deputy Director
4. Smt. IndraBeniwal, Deputy Director
5. Sh. Salim Hooda, Assistant District Attorney

The abovementioned committee submitted report dated 15.04.2021 wherein the date of appointment of Shri Kundan Kalra, Principal (Retd) was modified from 15.10.1991 to 25.10.1991. Resultantly, the seniority of Shri Kundan Kalra, Principal (Retd) was re-fixed from 1533 to 1701 A (as stood on 01.04.1998) and 1099 to 1269 A (as stood on 01.04.2005) vide order no. 15/64-2020 PGT-I(1) dated 27.07.2021/03.08.2021. Consequently, Shri Kundan Kalra [002823]

has now been placed in seniority between Sh. Sunil Kundu and Smt. Sudesh Kumari, therefore, his promotion date is to be rectified from 20.07.2007 to 21.04.2012.

That, Shri Kundan Kalra [002823], Principal (Retd) was given show cause notice dated 09.05.2022/10.05.2022 to explain his position that as to why his promotion orders should not be modified and be treated to promoted as Principal w.e.f 21.04.2012 and pay & pension be fixed accordingly.

That Shri Kundan Kalra [002823], Principal (Retd) submitted his reply to the show cause notice on 24.05.2022 and requested that promotion orders along with consequential pay/pension benefits may not be modified. Shri Kundan Kalra [002823], Principal (Retd) admitted in his reply dated 24.05.2022 that appointment of applicant as Lecturer is 25.10.1991 and never represented that the date of appointment of applicant as Lecturer was 15.10.1991.

Thereafter, Shri Kundan Kalra [002823], Principal (Retd) was given an opportunity of personal hearing on 01.09.2022 and he reiterated the contents of his earlier reply during the personal hearing. Thus, it is fairly established that Shri Kundan Kalra, Principal (Retd) has admitted that his date of joining as PGT was 25.10.1991 instead of 15.10.1991. In this way, the order passed by the Government on 27.07.2021/03.08.2021 regarding re-fixation of seniority of Shri Kundan Kalra is not disputed.

Keeping in view of the above and submission made by Shri Kundan Kalra during the personal hearing, it is found that Shri Kundan Kalra was wrongly mentioned at 1099 in the seniority of PGTs as stood on 01.04.2005 and promoted to the post of Principal on 20.07.2007 though this officer was to be promoted w.e.f. 21.04.2012, considering his seniority at 1269 A (as stood on 01.04.2005) as per order dated 27.07.2021/03.08.2021, i.e. date his seniors were promoted. Hence, the date of promotion as principal of Shri Kundan Kalra [002823], Principal (Retd) is modified from 20.07.2007 to 24.04.2012 though no recovery shall be made from him for the period he actually worked as principal and pension be re-fixed with immediate effect.

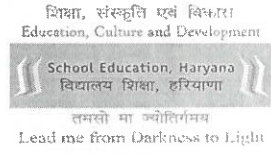



ORDER No. 13/96-2021 HRME-I (4) DATED, Panchkula, the 08-09-22

Whereas the petitioners had filed the CWP No. 9163 of 2021 titled as Reetu and others Vs State of Haryana & others, before the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the speaking order no. 13/120-2020 HRME-I (4) dated 13.04.2021 (Annexure P-13) qua the petitioners only wherein the relief sought in representation dated 21.08.2020 (Annexure P-6) has been declined.

The above said Civil Writ Petition came up for the adjudication before the Hon'ble Court on 12.07.2022 and the same was disposed of by the Hon'ble High Court. The operative part of the aforesaid orders is reproduced here as under:-

"Keeping in view the above, the present petitions are disposed of in the agreed terms that the petitions will file representation within a period of 7 days from today i.e. upto 18th of July, 2022 giving their options for transfer to the posts which are still lying vacant. The State is directed to decide the said representations in accordance with law coupled with the provisions of the policy with a sympathetic consideration so as to avoid any further litigation and to streamline the functioning of the schools concerned, within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

It is made clear that till the decision of the representation, the petitioners will be allowed to serve at the places where they are actually working now and in case, their representation is accepted and they are posted in a school which they have opted in the representation, they will join the same, otherwise, the petitioners will join schools where they have already been transferred by the respondents in the orders impugned in their petitions, which fact would be made clear by the respondents while deciding their representation. It is also made clear that a particular petitioner cannot opt for more than three schools in his representation and in case, any of the petitioners opt for the same posting, the length of the service should be taken into consideration while deciding their claim with regard to the option.

Civil miscellaneous applications No. CM-2758-CWP-2022 and CM- 1671-CWP-2021 in CWP No. 13810 of 2021, CM-13046-CWP-

2021 in CWP-9163-2021, CM-16284-CWP-2021 in CWP-15468-2021 and CM-5074-CWP-2022 in CWP-11116-2021 also stand disposed of.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the connected files."

In compliance of the above mentioned orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the representations dated 18.07.2022 of the petitioners were examined wherein all the petitioners have opted for 3-3 stations as per the orders of the Hon'ble High Court dated 12.07.2022. During the examination of the representations, it was found that as per the transfer policy dated 06.03.2020, some of the petitioners participated voluntarily, whereas some of the petitioners participated compulsorily on completion of their maximum 05 years stay in a particular zone. All the petitioners opted the stations according to their suitability and choices. But due to low merit scores obtained by them most of the petitioners could not get the stations opted by them. Such stations were given/allocated to the employees who have scored higher marks than the petitioners though some of the petitioners allocated the stations out of their preferences. Thus, the transfer of the petitioners has been done in a fair & transparent manner in strict compliance of the Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Earlier also the petitioners had filed the CWP No. 13085/2020 titled as Joginder Sharma and Others V/s State of Haryana and Others before the Hon'ble High Court with the prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside impugned order dated 14.08.2020 qua the petitioners.

The above said Civil Writ Petition came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on 28.01.2021 and same was disposed of with following orders:-

"In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the representation dated 21.08.2020 (P-10) expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within two weeks from today if there is no legal impediment. It is clarified that in case the desired representation is not decided within the stipulated time, the same shall be considered as disobedience of the order of this Court. It is also clarified that interim order dated 01.09.2020 will continue till the representation is decided in accordance with law. Since main writ petition stands disposed off, therefore, the pending applications, if any, shall also dispose off."

In-compliance of the above said orders of the Hon'ble High Court the department passed speaking order dated 13.04.2021 while rejecting the claim of the petitioners.

Whereas, the Government of Haryana framed Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020, thereupon, transfers were made under this policy to ensure equitable distribution of Ministerial Cadre Employees of the Department across the State, in a fair & transparent manner and to maximize job satisfaction amongst the employees. Under this policy all the government schools/ institutes have been categorized into seven zones for the purpose of transfer of clerks and every participant is eligible to opt for any number of schools/institutes across the zones available to him/her. He/ She is free to give preferences in order of his/her suitability, so that the chances of being posted in '**Anywhere in the State**' category may be decreased. Further, according to the Para No. 4 sub clause V (b) of the Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department is at liberty to post an employee anywhere in the State if he/she fails to get one of his/her preferred options. Thus the petitioners got the stations as per the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020.

Whereas the stations were blocked by following the process of rationalization. It is worthwhile to mention here that according to the sub clause-iv of Clause-4 of online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department can block actual vacant post for the purpose of rationalization. Sub clause-iv of Clause-4 online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020 is as under:-

iv) Rationalization and Blocking of posts: To avoid disproportionate concentration of employees at a particular station, the department should rationalize their sanctioned posts and also block actual vacant post to be kept vacant in the transfer drive. In the long run, however, the department may increase/decrease the total number of sanctioned posts as per the assessment/requirement in consultation with work Assessment Cell in the Administrative Reforms Department and Finance Department.

The posts with less workload were blocked by the department, because these stations with over workload require more employees for smooth working in the department. So, for maximum utilization of the potential of an employee at over work-loaded station and to avoid misappropriate concentration of employees at a particular station, the blocking of posts was done by the process of rationalization in the public interest.

Moreover, the stations were blocked by the department by following the proper criteria i.e. the schools in which student strength is less than 125 but where the strength of the students is more than 125 the transfer of clerks has been done as per the online transfer policy. Thus for the process of even distribution of clerks in the State the process of rationalization was done as per mandate of Clause 4 (iv) of Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Whereas it is germane to mention here that the blocked seats were opened only for the purpose of temporary posting of the clerks who later on joined the department after the present transfer drive by following the proper criteria and lowered the strength of students from 125 to 55 only for the purpose of temporary posting. It is pertinent to mention here that these new appointees will also have to compete with the order clerks in the next online transfer drive whenever the same will be conducted by the department.

Whereas as per the provision of the policy, allotment of a vacant seat/station to an employee is based on total composite score earned by the employee concerned out of total 80 score points. The employee concerned earning highest score is entitled to be transferred against a particular vacancy. For merit points, age is prime factor for deciding the claim of the employee against a vacancy, as it has weightage of maximum of 60 points out of total 80 points. However, it is worthwhile to mention here that the categories like women, widows, widowers, differently-abled persons, employees with serious ailments, a privilege of maximum 20 points can be availed by the employees. Therefore, the employees were asked to opt for maximum stations as per their choice suitable to them so that their chances of getting posted on an un-opted station in 'anywhere in the state category' may be reduced. In other words, if a employee could not be transferred against any of the stations preferred by him/her, he/she shall be transferred under '**Anywhere in the State**' category. In case, an employee is to be transferred on an un-opted station in "Anywhere in state" category then Computer Programme/Software, instead of sending them at a distance place, searches for a vacancy nearest to them and put them at that vacancy as per their merit points.

Whereas, according to general principles of the policy, every employee is responsible for the accuracy and regular updation of data in MIS in respect of his/her credentials, otherwise the department is at liberty to transfer him/her, in anywhere category in the state. Employees are liable

to be transferred under this policy in any zone or anywhere in the State, in public interest, on completion of prescribed tenure.



In compliance of the above mentioned orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the representations of the petitioners of different dates were examined wherein all the petitioners have opted for 3-3 stations as per the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 12.07.2022. During the examination of the representations, it was found that as per the transfer policy dated 06.03.2020, some of the petitioners participated voluntarily, whereas some of the petitioners participated compulsorily of completion of their maximum 05 years stay in a particular zone. All the petitioners opted stations according to their suitability and choices. But due to low merit scores obtained by them, the petitioners did not get station opted by them. Such stations were given/allocated to the employees who have scored higher marks than the petitioners. Thus transfer of the petitioners has been done in a fair & transparent manner in strict compliance of the Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Earlier also the petitioners had filed the CWP No. 13682/2020 titled as Hanuman and Others V/s State of Haryana and Others with the prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside impugned transfer orders dated 14.08.2020 qua the petitioners.

The above said Civil Writ Petition came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on 28.01.2021 and same was disposed of with following orders:-

"In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the representation dated 21.08.2020 (P-10) expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within two weeks from today if there is no legal impediment. It is clarified that in case the desired representation is not decided within the stipulated time, the same shall be considered as disobedience of the order of this Court. It is also clarified that interim order dated 01.09.2020 will continue till the representation is decided in accordance with law. Since main writ petition stands disposed off, therefore, the pending applications, if any, shall also dispose off."

In compliance of the above said orders of the Hon'ble High Court the department passed speaking order dated 14.06.2021 while rejecting the claim of the petitioners.

Whereas, the Government of Haryana framed Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020, there upon, transfers were made under this policy to ensure equitable distribution of Ministerial Cadre Employees of the Department across the State, in a fair & transparent manner and to maximize job satisfaction amongst the employees. Under this policy all the government schools/ institutes have been categorized into seven zones for the purpose of transfer of clerks and every participant is eligible to opt for any number of schools/institutes across the zones available to him/her. He/ She is free to give preferences in order of his/her suitability, so that chances of being posted in '**Anywhere in the State**' category may be decreased. Further, according to the Para No. 4 sub clause V (b) of the Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department is at liberty to post an employee anywhere in the State if he/she fails to get one of his/her preferred options. Thus the petitioners got the stations as per the online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020.

Whereas the stations were blocked by following the process of rationalization. It is worthwhile to mention here that according to the sub clause-iv of Clause-4 of online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020, the department can block actual vacant post for the purpose of rationalization. Sub clause-iv of Clause-4 online transfer policy of Ministerial Staff 2020 is as under:-

iv) Rationalization and Blocking of posts: To avoid disproportionate concentration of employees at a particular station, the department should rationalize their sanctioned posts and also block actual vacant post to be kept vacant in the transfer drive. In the long run, however, the department may increase/decrease the total number of sanctioned posts as per the assessment/requirement in consultation with work Assessment Cell in the Administrative Reforms Department and Finance Department.

The posts with less workload were blocked by the department, because these stations with over workload require more employees for smooth working in the department. So, for maximum utilization of the potential of an employee at over work-loaded station and to avoid misappropriate concentration of employees at a particular station, the blocking of posts was done by the process of rationalization in the public interest.

Moreover, the stations were blocked by the department by following the proper criteria i.e. the schools in which student strength is less than 125 but where the strength of the students is more than 125 the transfer of clerks has been done as per the online transfer policy. Thus for the process of even distribution of clerks in the State the process of rationalization was done as per mandate of Clause 4 (iv) of Online Transfer Policy of Ministerial Staff dated 06.03.2020.

Whereas it is germane to mention here that the blocked seats were opened only for the purpose of temporary posting of the clerks who later on joined the department after the present transfer drive by following the proper criteria and lowered the strength of students from 125 to 55 only for the purpose of temporary posting. It is pertinent to mention here that these new appointees will also have to compete with the order clerks in the next online transfer drive whenever the same will be conducted by the department.

Whereas as per the provision of the policy, allotment of a vacant seat/station to an employee is based on total composite score earned by the employee concerned out of total 80 score points. The employee concerned earning highest score is entitled to be transferred against a particular vacancy. For merit points, age is prime factor for deciding the claim of the employee against a vacancy, as it has weightage of maximum of 60 points out of total 80 points. However, it is worthwhile to mention here that the categories like women, widows, widowers, differently-abled persons, employees with serious ailments, a privilege of maximum 20 points can be availed by the employees. Therefore, the employees were asked to opt for maximum stations as per their choice suitable to them so that their chances of getting posted on an un-opted station in 'anywhere in the state category' may be reduced. In other words, if a employee could not be transferred against any of the stations preferred by him/her, he/she shall be transferred under '**Anywhere in the State**' category. In case, an employee is to be transferred on an un-opted station in "Anywhere in state" category then Computer Programme/Software, instead of sending them at a distance place, searches for a vacancy nearest to them and put them at that vacancy as per their merit points.

Whereas, according to general principles of the policy, every employee is responsible for the accuracy and regular updation of data in MIS in respect of his/her credentials, otherwise the department is at liberty to transfer him/her, in anywhere category in the state. Employees are liable

to be transferred under this policy in any zone or anywhere in the State, in public interest, on completion of prescribed tenure.


