Subject: Extending benefit of RBSK programme to children of EWS category studying in private schools of Haryana.

Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) is a national health programme implemented through National Health Mission in States.

Under the programme, children from birth to 18 years of age, who are enrolled in Anganwadis and Government schools are being screened and managed for the selected health conditions categorized broadly under 4 Ds (Defects at birth, Diseases, Deficiencies and Development Delays including Disabilities).

Considering the fact that substantial number of children are enrolled in private schools under Economically weaker section (EWS) quota, NHM Haryana proposed to manage the already identified children free of cost who require intervention at secondary and tertiary level health facilities. This proposal was intended to curb the financial burden on the part of family and to facilitate early treatment of the suffering children without competing with their household chores.

It gives me immense pleasure to inform you that Government of India has agreed and approved our proposal in the public interest. Further, to reach the target beneficiaries, the support of School Education Department is solicited in disseminating this information to all private

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schools of Haryana and to mobilize the identified beneficiary to District Early Intervention Centre (DEIC) of the respective District Civil Hospital for their management. The brief guidelines for the same including the list of health conditions to be covered and list of the nodal officers in the district is attached herewith for reference.

You are requested to issue directions to the concerned officer dealing with private schools for the needful.

Subject: Treatment of children from Economically weaker Section (EWS category) under Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK)

As you are aware that RBSK is an important initiative aiming at early identification and intervention for children from birth to 18 years to cover 4 'D's viz. Defects at birth, Deficiencies, Diseases. Development delays including disability. Facility based newborn screening is done at health facilities. Community based newborn screening is being done at home through ASHAs (Accredited Social Health Activist) and for children (6 weeks-18 years), 211 Mobile Health Teams conduct biannual screening at Anganwadis and annual screening in Govt./Govt. aided schools.

The children identified with health conditions are referred and given primary and secondary level treatment services at the Govt. Health facilities including District Early Intervention Centre at the level of Civil Hospital. For secondary and tertiary level surgeries Private hospitals have been empanelled apart from approved Govt. Institutions.

As continued activity approval has been received for providing secondary/tertiary treatment under RBSK to the children (6-18 years) of Private schools whose parents fall in the EWS category for selected health conditions (List enclosed herewith). These children can avail the treatment services at the Empanelled Private Hospitals and approved Govt. Institutions and under RBSK. However no screening will be done in the Private schools. The children suffering

from the selected health conditions need to visit the DEIC. The principal of the concerned school should coordinate with the Deputy Civil Surgeon RBSK (Dy. CS RBSK).

The eligible child suffering from any of the health condition mentioned in the list attached may approach the DEIC along with copy of Copy of AADHAR Card of the child /Parents (If Child AADHAR card is not available). EWS certificate copy and School Certificate verified and signed by the Head/Principal of the concerned school (Format enclosed). The child will be registered at DEIC and supported for getting the treatment following due procedure at the approved./empanelled hospitals. This whole activity will be coordinated by the DEIC manager /DEIC Incharge /RBSK coordinator under supervision of Dy. Civil Surgeon RBSK (District Nodal Officer for RBSK) (Contact details enclosed herewith). Besides the aforesaid documents, an affidavit will have to be submitted by the Parents/Caregiver after approval of the case.

In view of the above, you are requested to widely disseminate this information to all the concerned officers/officials dealing with private schools of Haryana in the public interest so that they may further inform all the parents /caregiver and all the eligible and needy children requiring financial help may be supported for treatment under RBSK.
