The Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) aims to develop the backbone necessary to support the integrated digital health infrastructure of the country. It will bridge the existing gap amongst different stakeholders of healthcare ecosystem through digital highways, making healthcare available, accessible and affordable. As you may be aware, ABDM has successfully completed one year of nationwide implementation. During this phase, about 25 crore Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) have been created and more than 2 crore digital health records have been linked to citizens' ABHA.

2. The interoperable platform created through ABDM enables creation of longitudinal electronic health records for every citizen. Through ABHA and ABDM enabled Personal Health Record (PHR) applications, citizens shall have the facility to link, securely store and access their medical records digitally. This gives citizens complete control over their health records and ability to choose what to share with their healthcare providers. The Indian School Education System is one of the largest in the world with more than 15 lakh schools and nearly 26.5 crore students of pre primary to higher secondary level from varied socio-economic backgrounds. Moreover, over 76% of the children are already enrolled with Aadhaar. Creating ABHA for children through this vast school network will help in development of longitudinal health records of children from a very early age.

3. There are a number of applications through which ABHA can be created. These include ABHA App, Aarogya Setu besides other applications developed by private players like Paytm, DRiefcase, Ekacare etc. The procedure for creation of ABHA is annexed herewith for your reference.

Therefore, it is kindly requested that a mass ABHA creation and ABDM awareness drive may be initiated in all the educational institutions in your State/UT focussing on creation of ABHA and linking of digital health records including vaccination records. This will provide lifelong benefits to the children and will also strengthen the digital healthcare ecosystem of the country.
